ENTERING TODAY'S GAME

Erie's bullpen game worked again as Brant Hurter continues to dominant in long relief. Brendan White, Gerson Moreno, and Adam Wolf all grinded through tough innings with the game-tying or go-ahead run at the plate to perserve the victory. Reese Olson makes his 26th appearance (25th start) and looks to throw some quality innings to give the SeaWolves relievers some much needed rest. Olson is coming off back-to-back wins for the second time this season. The Tigers #9 prospect has been one of the best pitchers in the Eastern League, ranking second with 159 strikeouts and eight wins, fourth with a 4.15 ERA, and seventh with 115 innings pitched. Olson has a 1-1 record in five career starts against Richmond along with a 3.86 ERA over 23.1 innings. Landen Roupp makes his fifth start for the Flying Squirrels. He has struck out 29 and walked nine in 21.1 innings of work, pitching to a .200 BAA and a 1.17 WHIP.

LAST GAME

The first place Erie SeaWolves gutted out a 5-3 win in 11 innings on Wednesday night against the Richmond Flying Squirrels at The Diamond. The win, coupled with a Bowie win over Akron, keeps Erie with a one-game lead in the standings (with a tie breaker) over the Baysox and gives them a three-game lead over the RubberDucks.

The SeaWolves took the lead in the third against Richmond starter Kyle Harrison. Harrison retired the first eight batters of the game before Danny Serretti singed to extend the inning with his first Double-A knock. Dane Myers doubled home Serretti for a 1-0 lead. Spot starter Elvis Alvarado gave Erie two scoreless innings before handing it over to Brant Hurter. Hurter kept Richmond off the board hurling 4.2 scoreless. Hurter got into trouble in the seventh and left the game with runners on the corners with two outs. Brendan White struck out Ricardo Genoves to get Erie out of the jam. Erie grew the lead to 2-0 in the top of the eighth. Daniel Cabrera led off with a single against releiver Evan Gates and moved to second on a Myers walk. Parker Meadows doubled home Cabrera with his second of three hits on the night.

Richmond tied the game in the last of the eighth. Shane Matheny singled off of White with one out. White indued a flyout from Tyler Fitzgerald for the second out. He then worked to an 0-2 count on Diego Rincones before yielding a game-tying two-run home run. Rincones has now homered in consecutive games in the series. White stayed in the game and struck out the side in the ninth, sending the game to extra innings. The SeaWolves could not plate a run in the top of the 10th and turned the ball to Gerson Moreno in the bottom of the 10th inning. Genoves attempted to bunt the free runner to third but popped out to Gage Workman at third. Pinch-hitter Riley Mahan singled and advanced to second on a throw putting runners on second and third for the Squirrels. Moreno then struck out Fitzgerald and Rincones to strand the bases loaded.

Richmond summed reliever Clay Helvey for the top of the 11th. Andrew Navigato led off and grounded out to second, advancing the free runner Myers to third. With the infield playing in, Meadows singled to center with his third hit of the night to plate the go-ahead run. Helvey struck out Quincy Nieporte for the second out bringing up Josh Crouch. Crouch clobbered his first Double-A home run to straight away center, giving the SeaWolves a 5-2 lead. Adam Wolf worked the bottom of the 11th inning for Erie. He retired Will Wilson for the first out before giving up a single to Casey Schmitt putting runners on the corners. Tristan Peters grounded out, plating the free runner in Rincones to make it 5-3. Wolf induced a game-ending groundout from Carter Aldrete to earn his fourth save. Moreno (4-2) earned the win after throwing the scoreless 10th. He allowed one hit with an intentional walk and a pair of strikeouts. Moreno has earned the win on the first two games of the series. Helvey (1-2) took the loss allowing three runs, two earned, on two hits with no walks and two strikeouts.

- Erie's magic number to clinch the playoffs is three.
- Gerson Moreno is the first SeaWolf to win back-to-back games since Joe Jimenez accomplished the feat on June 11-12, 2016. - Erie has won more games in the second half (40) than it did in the first half (39).
- Quincy Nieporte is first in the Eastern league with 30 HRs, 88 RBIs, 57 extra base hits, and 239 total bases. Nieporte is second with a .538 SLG and a .869 OPS, sixth with 70 runs scored and 120 hits, and seventh with a .270 batting average.
- Dane Myers is third with a .510 SLG, tied for sixth in the league with 24 homers and 199 total bases, seventh with a .827 OPS, eighth with a .269 batting average, and 10th with 69 RBIs.
- Parker Meadows is fifth in the Eastern League with a .280 batting average and an .833 OPS. He is also ninth with a .355 OBP.

Crouch mentioned that he is being held accountable by Pena, which has allowed him to play at his best. He's lost 10-12 pounds since the season started, eating healthy food whenever he has the chance and receiving postgame meals from his host family. At the plate, Crouch he eliminated his stride when he gets into his batting stance, adjusted to off speed and breaking pitches, and his mechanics as a hitter...featured in an article by Lynn Henning of The Detroit News on August 7. Crouch has worked with West Michigan development coach Nick Bredeson on receiving more strikes at the bottom of the zone and on the edges. Bredeson also said his game-calling has improved. Whitecaps hitting coach CJ Wamsley also had a high praise for the young catcher. Wamsley said he can hit velo, spin, righties, lefties, beat out shifts, hits with intent, focuses on improving his swing, and understands game situations.
