Frontier League Roster Eligibility




ROSTER ELIGIBILITY RULES

- There are three different types of classifications for players in the Frontier League: Professional, Experienced, and Veteran.
- Players who complete a season at 24 years old or younger will be Professional-1 classification. Players who complete a season at 25 years old will be no more than a Professional-2 classification. Players who complete a season at 26 years old will be no more than an Experienced-1 classification. Players who complete a season at ages 27-29 will be an Experienced-2 classification. Players who complete a season at 30 years old or higher will be a Veteran classification. For all classification levels, the player's age as of September 30 will be used to determine the age portion of their classification.
- There are a couple of exceptions to these rules. Players who have served on active military duty will receive
 an exemption to the age limit for any classification of one year for each year of active duty that was served.
 Position players who are switching to pitching and pitchers who are switching to playing a position will have
 their classifications reset to Professional-1 provided that they do not appear in any games at their previous
 position (batting/running or pitching, depending on the switch).
- Regular season and playoff rosters will be composed of the following players: a minimum of 10 players
 of Professional-1 or Professional-2 classification, a minimum of 6 players of Experienced-1 classification
 (adjusted down if more than 10 Professionals are on the roster), a maximum of 8 players of Experienced-2
 or Veteran classification, up to two of these 8 players may be Veteran classification
- Players without prior affiliated baseball (MiLB) experience must be at least 18 years old to play in the Frontier League. Regular season and playoff rosters will be composed of a minimum of 22 active players and a maximum of 24 active players.
 - During the offseason, teams may have no more than thirty-four (34) players on their active roster. There is no classification limit for the off-season roster. Players signed out of the California Winter League or selected in the Frontier League Draft are exempt from the 34-player limit. The Sunday prior to Opening Day, teams must be down to 28 players. Regular season and playoff rosters will be composed of a minimum of 22 active players and a maximum of 24 active players.





THE ELK GROVE, CA NATIVE WILL SPLIT TIME ON THE DIRT AMIDST THE STRUGGLES FROM DJ LEMAHIEU AND OSWALDO CABRERA AS ANTHONY RIZZO MAKES HIS WAY BACK FROM THE INJURED LIST.



ValleyCats 2024 Coaching Staff



Greg Tagert, Field Manager

Greg Tagert enters his first season at the helm with the ValleyCats, and his 29th season as a manager of a pro baseball team. He returns to the Frontier League after being a a skipper for several teams, in 1995 and 1997-2004. The Carlsbad, N.M. native was at the helm for the first three championships with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2005, 2007, 2013) in the American Association of Professional Baseball (AAPB), and earned the Manager of the Year award in three different seasons (2001, 2007, 2009). Overall, he was the skipper in Gary from 2005-2021. Tagert was also the manager of the San Francisco Giants Arizona Complex League affiliate in 2022, and was at the helm with the Winnipeg Goldeyes in 2023 of the AAPB.

Tom Thornton, Pitching Coach

Tom Thornton joins Tagert on his coaching staff for the third time in his career. The University of Notre Dame product was the pitching coach for Tagert last year with the Goldeyes, and with the RailCats from 2020-21. Thornton and Tagert have known each other for quite some time; Thornton was a player for Tagert's RailCats from 2009-10 back when they were in the Northern League. The left-hander has several additional connections to the ValleyCats; he was a pitcher back in the New York-Penn League in 2006 for the Oneonta Tigers, and played in the Frontier League for the Traverse City Beach Bums in 2007, and the Evansville Otters in 2008.

Tom McManus, Fundamentals Coach

Tom McManus was a Milwaukee Brewers Arizona Complex League (ACL) development coach in 2023. The ACL Brewers won their league championship last season. Beforehand, the Eldersburg, Md. native was the defensive coordinator at D1 Norfolk State University in 2022, and worked with the infielders and catchers. The Salisbury University graduate was also the Director of Baseball Operations at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), and held the same title at the National Baseball Club Association in Pittsburgh.

Joe Torre, Third Base Coach

Joe Torre was a scouting consultant for Tagert for six years. He owns Black Sox Pro Baseball, which has gotten 200 players to MLB Partner Leagues out of the Yinzer Baseball Confederacy from 2020-23, over 600 players to MLB Partner Leagues since 2019, and more than 20 of his players signed to MLB Partner Leagues have also made the Majors since 2016. The New Jersey native is well-versed in independent baseball, spending several years as a player/coach, even advancing to the Washington League championship in 2020 as his Road Warrior Black Sox defeated the Washington Wild Things in the semifinals. His dog, Michael Keaton, can often been seen around the clubhouse with Torre.



VALLEYCATS TO WEAR COLLAR CITY CATS JERSEYS ON AUGUST 12TH





The Tri-City ValleyCats are proud to present their 2024 specialty "Collar City Cats" jerseys. These alternates honor the rich history of Troy, NY, also known as the Collar City. These uniforms proudly represent the baseball lineage of the area that the ValleyCats call home. The 'Cats will be wearing these jerseys one last time this season on August 10th. Fitted Collar City Cats hats, shirts, and hoodies will continue to be available in SouthPaw's Den.

Specifically, Troy is home to the "detachable collar" and the "bishop collar", which were central during the industrial revolution. The 'Cats are paying homage to the impact that the collar industry had on Troy. At the turn of the 20th century, 15,000 people worked in the collar industry in Troy, 85% of which were women, and 90% of collars made in the United States at the time came from Troy. The riverfront was dotted with collar factories as well with many of those industrial buildings repurposed or redeveloped as part of the city's rebirth.

Furthermore, professional baseball such as the Troy Haymakers (1871-72) and the Troy Trojans (1879-82) came to the Collar City in the late 19th century. The lineage of the San Francisco Giants can be traced back to the Trojans with the Giants returning their 2010 World Series trophy for an event at Joe Bruno Stadium to celebrate this history in 2011. The 'Cats have honored Troy's baseball heritage in the past as Hall of Famer Johnny Evers (1946) was a Troy native, and had his very own bobblehead in 2014. As a whole, the Haymakers and the Trojans sported five Hall of Famers in Buck Ewing (1939), Roger Connor (1945), Dan Brouthers (1945), Tim Keefe (1964), and Mickey Welch (1973).

The ValleyCats have crafted a throwback design with green lettering across the chest, green numbers on the back, and a cream colored jersey with pants that have green piping. The Collar City Cats logo also features interlocking collars with an alternate mark including an iron to pay tribute to the city's heritage. We are excited to don these NOVUS jerseys to recognize Troy's baseball and industrial history.



How to Keep Score







Each at-bat is written in the box next to the player under the inning that the at-bat occured. If a player reaches base, you can indicate it by drawing a line that indicates how far along the diamond the player has progressed, while also writing down the corresponding abbreviation (below) relating to the play that occured.

In the example above, James hit a single and stole second base. Roberts hit a flyball out to center field, and was followed by Murphy, who hit a two-RBI home run, driving in James. Following the home run, Sanchez reached base on an error by the second baseman, and Simmons ended the inning by hitting into a double play to the shortstop, who threw to the second baseman, who then threw to first.



Chas Cywin - Survivor

Before Cywin's Pro Career, He Was a Childhood Cancer Survivor

Charles Cywin Jr. was born on January 21st, 1998. He grew up being called Chas as his father goes by Chuck, and his uncle goes by Charlie. Chas had leukemia from when he was 19 months old to when he was four or five. Cywin did not have complete remission until he was 12. The future ValleyCats starter hails from Bethel, CT, and he traveled a half an hour away to White Plains, NY with his mother for 8 AM appointments for three consecutive years for cancer treatment, including chemotherapy.

Cywin's aunts, uncles, cousins, and grandparents were able to provide support as most of his family resides less than three hours away in the Massachusetts/Rhode Island area. He grew up an only child, but his cousins are like his brothers and sisters; the 26-year-old still has a close relationship with them today.

Cywin never felt sorry for himself during the process, and remained strong for his family. Growing up a Boston Red Sox fan, Cywin idolized their ace, Jon Lester. He grew a deep appreciation for the left-hander who was diagnosed with a treatable form of anaplastic large cell lymphoma in 2006, only to come back the next year, and earn his first of three World Series championships.

He made the All-Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference Second Team in 2022 for Post University, and played for the Division II team in the New England Intercollegiate Baseball Association All-Star Game at Dunkin Donuts Stadium. home of the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies Double-A affiliate). It was the second time Cywin pitched at Dunkin Donuts Stadium, as the year prior he faced off against Team Israel before they played in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

Cywin signed with the New Jersey Jackals after college in the summer of 2022. He later joined the Long Island Ducks of the Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. Last year, Cywin split time between Greg Tagert's Winnipeg Goldeyes, and the reigning Frontier League champs, the Quebec Capitales. Cywin overcame immense hurdles, and is now a resource to younger players for Tri-City, who can go to and ask him questions about being a professional, and being part of a winning culture.





Tyson Gingerich's Amish Background



Tyson Gingerich's Amish Background

Tyson Gingerich hails from Mt. Hope, Ohio, just 10 minutes away from Berlin. He grew up on a farm along with his parents, his older sister MacKenzie and his younger brother Tanner. According to the 2020 Census, Mt. Hope has just 197 people. His hometown is part of Holmes County, which has the second largest Amish population in the United States at nearly 37,000 people.

Amish living generally consists of a very limited use of electronics, at times utilizing a horse drawn carriage instead of automobiles. It also includes large families, modest and peaceful living, and a formal education stopping after eighth grade. Most come from agricultural backgrounds, and despite separating themselves from the modern world, the foods produced in Amish areas are often sold in nearby markets. Additionally, those who are born Amish have the freedom to move on from the community, but it is very difficult to return if one changes their mind.

Growing up, Gingerich went to school with Amish children in his hometown up until high school. Both his parents grew up Amish, and eventually split away from the community. His mother, Regina, was the only one out of her 15 siblings to step away from her Amish background. On his paternal side, Gingerich's grandparents split away from the community, when Tyson's father, Daniel, was 10 years old. According to Gingerich, although it is unusual for Amish people to play baseball, there is an affinity for slow pitch softball. His father even played in tournaments around the country such as in California and Texas.

Clearly his father's athletic ability was passed down to Tyson, who set several records at D2 Malone University in Canton, Ohio. He played with the Pioneers from 2019-2023, and set the program record for career runs scored (183), career stolen bases (130), and the most stolen bases in a single season (47 in 2023).

Down the line, Gingerich hopes to be a college baseball coach, and would like to use his MBA to be a project manager for building houses. Coming from a unique background, there is more than meets the eye off the field, as he continues to dazzle ValleyCats fans with his speed and defense on the field.
