MARCELLA'S HOT ZONE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: RHP Nick DeCarlo has yielded just one run in his last four appearances (10.1 innings pitched), and has struck out 23 batters during that span.

A WILD WEEKEND: Tri-City only scored in three frames during the the 29 innings against the Ottawa Titans over the weekend, and were also held scoreless for 18.2 consecutive innings. The ValleyCats overcame a 1-0 deficit in eighth thanks to a Jaxon Hallmark two-run single, but a pair of controversial calls in the final two frames handed Tri-City a 3-2 loss in 10 frames.

JOE TO THE SHOW: OF George Springer ('11) belted two homers for the Toronto Blue Jays yesterday in their 7-3 win over the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park. He is one long ball away from his eighth 20+ homer season.

LAST GAME RECAP (8/25/24):

TROY, NY - The Tri-City ValleyCats (49-39) brought in a season-high 5,488 fans to Joseph L. Bruno Stadium on Sunday for the final regular season home game, but ultimately fell 3-2 in 10 innings to the Ottawa Titans (51-38). Since the New York Boulders fell 8-5 to the Québec Capitales at Clover Stadium, the ValleyCats magic number to make the postseason for the first time since 2018 dwindles down to three.

Ottawa opened the scoring in the second. Brendan O'Donnell singled off Alfredo Ruiz. Christian Ibarra walked before Jake Hjelle singled in a run to put the Titans on top, 1-0. Brett Rodriguez kept it a one-run contest, starting a 9-4-2 putout to nail down Ibarra, trying to score on the single from Hjelle.

Tri-City countered in the eighth. Tyson Gingerich singled against CJ Blowers. Rodriguez bunted, and reached on a fielder's choice as Gingerich moved to second. Both runners advanced on a passed ball. Jaxon Hallmark then came through in the clutch with a two-run single to pull the ValleyCats ahead, 2-1.

Ottawa responded in the ninth. Austin Dill walked Jamey Smart. Jackie Urbabaez replaced Smart, and stole second before moving to third on a wild pitch. Peyton Issacson delivered a pinch-hit RBI single to make it a 2-2 affair.

Ruiz received a no-decision. He matched a professional-high with eight innings, yielding one run on four hits, walking three, and striking out four.

Blowers was handed a no-decision. He pitched seven frames, giving up two runs on 10 hits, and striking out one.

The Titans retook the lead in the 10th. Hjelle laid down a sac bunt, and Ibarra went to third. AJ Wright picked up an RBI infield single to provide Ottawa with a 3-2 advantage.

McLain Harris recorded his second save after retiring the side in order in the 10th.

Jake Dixon (1-1) earned the win. He finished the ninth, and tossed 0.2 scoreless innings, walking one. Dill (3-1) was handed the loss. He tossed two frames, allowing two runs, one earned on two hits, walking two, and striking out two.

COACHING STAFF

#37 GREG TAGERT, FIELD MANAGER

2024 will mark the 29th season in which Tagert has managed a professional baseball club. He has spent the bulk of his career in the American Association with the Winnipeg Goldeyes (2023) and the Gary SouthShore Railcats (2011-2021). Tagert is the 12th manager in the ValleyCats 22-season history. The San Francisco State University alum was also at the helm for the RailCats from 2005-2010 when they were in the Northern League. In between his two stints with the American Association, Tagert was the Field Manager for the rookie ball affiliate of the San Francisco Giants in the Arizona Complex League in 2022.

The upcoming season will represent a bit of a homecoming as Tagert was a skipper in the Frontier League in 1995, and from 1997-2004. He began his managerial career with the Ohio Valley Redcoats in 1995. After a brief stint in 1996 with the Brainerd Bobcats in the Prairie League, Tagert managed the Evansville Otters from 1997-2000. He was also at the helm with the Dubois County Dragons (2001-2002), Kenosha Mammoths (2003), and Springfield/Ozark Ducks (2004).

Additional experiences for Tagert include his time as a scouting consultant for the Boston Red Sox and the Detroit Tigers. Prior to his tenure with the Bobcats, he coached at the University of New Mexico. Tagert has accumulated numerous accolades throughout his tenure as a skipper, such as being at the helm for the first three championships with the RailCats (2005, 2007, 2013), earning the Manager of the Year award in three different seasons (2001, 2007, 2009), compiling a 1,315-1,183 managerial record (.526 win percentage), and working with over 60 players that have moved on to MLB clubs.

#30 TOM THORNTON, PITCHING COACH

Tom Thornton joins Tagert on his coaching staff for the third time in his career. The University of Notre Dame product was the pitching coach for Tagert in the American Association of Professional Baseball last year with the Winnipeg Goldeyes, and with the Gary Southshore RailCats from 2020-21. Thornton and Tagert have known each other for quite some time; Thornton was a player for Tagert's RailCats from 2009-10 back when they were in the Northern League.

Thornton was originally drafted by the Detroit Tigers in the 21st round of the 2006 MLB Draft. The connections run even deeper as his lone season of minor league ball, also in 2006, came with the Oneonta Tigers in the New York-Penn League. Thornton was a left-handed pitcher for several independent teams such as the Traverse City Beach Bums and Evansville Otters in the Frontier League, the Nashua Pride in the Can-Am League, and the Schaumburg Flyers in the Northern League. Overall, Thornton earned 14 wins and tossed 342.2 innings across five professional seasons.

#5 TOM MCMANUS, FUNDAMENTALS COACH

McManus was a Milwaukee Brewers Arizona Complex League (ACL) development coach in 2023. The ACL Brewers won their league championship last season. Beforehand, the Eldersburg, Md. native was the defensive coordinator at D1 Norfolk State University in 2022, and worked with the infielders and catchers.

The Salisbury University graduate also had coaching stints in youth baseball with the Eastern Shore Force, the Triple Crown Training, and the Evoshield Canes. McManus was the Director of Baseball Operations at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), and held the same title with the National Club Baseball Association in Pittsburgh. At UMBC, he helped implement Synergy Baseball, and created scouting and analytics reports; these skills will translate over into utilizing the Frontier League's Yakkertech system.

#15 JOE TORRE, ASSISTANT COACH

Joe Torre was a scouting consultant for Tagert for six years. The 40-year-old is the owner of Black Sox Pro Baseball, which has gotten 200 players to MLB Partner Leagues out of the Yinzer Baseball Confederacy from 2020-23, over 600 to MLB Partner Leagues since 2019, and more than 20 of his players signed to MLB Partner Leagues have also made the Majors since 2016. The New Jersey native is well-versed in independent baseball, spending several years as a player/coach. In 2022, he was a consultant to Brooks Carey, then-manager of the New Jersey Jackals, who became the 2023 Pitching Coach for the 'Cats.

In 2020, he was a GM and player for two teams (the Road Warrior Black Sox and Brilliance Sox) in the four-team pod out of Washington called the Yinzer Baseball Confederacy; his Black Sox swept the Wild Things in the playoffs. From 2017-2019, Torre worked in the Pacific Association with the Pittsburg Diamonds, and in 2019 was with the Vallejo Admirals. Back in 2012, he was the first base coach for the El Paso Diablos. His playing experience includes his time with the Serie A2 division with the Riccione Dolphins in Italy during the 2009 campaign, along with the Roswell Invaders of the Pecos League in 2012, as well as the Diamonds in 2018, and the Admirals in 2019.

#28 J.T. SCARA, BENCH COACH

- Was at the helm with the Jackson Rockabillys in the Prospect League in Tennessee before coming over to Tri-City.
- Led the Bo Jackson Elite Sports Advanced Catchers Christmas Camp in 2023
- Managed several seasons in the Northwoods League, and was with the Rockford Rivets from 2019-2022, and the Kenosha Kingfish in 2023.
- Was the Hitting Coach for Jamie Bennett of the Schaumburg Boomers from 2018-19
- Worked alongside as the Catchers/Third Base Coach for Greg Tagert with the Gary SouthShore RailCats in 2016-17.
- Spent three seasons from 2012-2014 as the assistant coach at McKendree University...the Bearcats are a DII program in the Great Leakes Valley Conference... originally they were a NAIA program until July of 2013.
- Native of New Lenox, Ill., was an assistant coach at Robert Morris University in Chicago. In the spring of 2012, Scara was the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Eagles while also coaching third base during games...they earned a trip to the 2011 NAIA World Series Opening Round.
- Used to serve as an Assistant/Bullpen/BP Coach for the Windy City ThunderBolts for two seasons; they were Eastern Division champions in 2010, and hosted the All-Star Game in 2011
- Two-year starter in right field at Moraine Valley Community College in Palos Hills, Ill., where he hit .305 as a sophomore. He moved on to Rockford College, where he helped lead the Regents to a Northern Athletics Conference (NAC) regular-season and tournament championship. Rockford College (now Rockford University) is located in Rockford, Illinois, and are a DIII team.
- Has a wife, Nicole, and two daughters, Jayce and Josephine
