(DE-FI) acquired Dayton Fashion Week



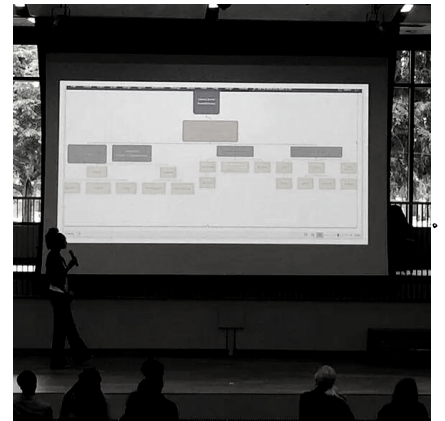
2017
