Track Rules

Race director has the ultimate authority over rules listed here or otherwise

Tire Sauce is <u>NOT</u> allowed

Chassis Protector- There will be a grace period until April 1st. After April 1st, Chassis Protectors are required.

- February March: Drives will have to show their car <u>before each</u>
 <u>race</u> to an appointed person that is assigned by the RD. The RD will
 announce the person that will be inspecting the RC car prior to the first
 race of the night.
- April A Chassis Protector is required. However, for new/first time drives the RD can allow him/her to race after inspecting the car prior to each race.

Marshaling - All drivers are required to marshal or have an appointed marshal on their behalf if he/she cannot marshal or have back-to-back races.

TRVC is enforcing the following marshaling rule:

- A 3-minute timer will be started at the end of each race allowing drivers that left the driver stand to get their cars back to their pits or on the stand next to the track, and then back out on the track to marshal.
- After 3 minutes if you or your appointed marshal is not on the track you will be docked a lap on your next race.
- If you appointed someone to marshal on your behalf, it is still your responsibility as the driver to ensure that individual is out on the track within the 3 minutes to marshal. If not, you will be docked 1 lap on your next race, not the appointed marshal.

Racer Etiquette

All participants will treat other drivers, marshals, & spectators with upmost respect. TVRC facilities are family friendly, and all racers must control their behavior accordingly. Above all, practice good sportsmanship to keep the environment fun for all. While on the driver stand no conversation between racers to prevent distracting another driver's race.

Absolutely no yelling or complaining about marshaling.

In the event a racer's vehicle breaks during a race, that racer is required to stay on the drivers stand until the race has finished.

Track Procedures

All sign-ups must be completed 30 mins before the start of racing. Prior to beginning of each event, the race director will hold a brief driver meeting to go over basic track rules and racer etiquette. Announcement of the first race will immediately follow driver meeting.

Drivers will have two minutes after the announcement of a qualifier or main to get their vehicle onto the track and in position to start the race. Drivers can call 1-minute only prior to main events where they need more time to repair their car.

All drivers must turn marshal the race immediately following their race or find a qualified substitute. All vehicles will be made available for tech inspection before or after race. Technical inspections can be random or formatted by the race director. Racers under 12 years of age may not marshal for safety reasons. Parents or volunteers are asked to marshal for the younger racers. Please be helpful and quickly volunteer to marshal when needed. As the discretion of the race director, if there are less than 3 entries for a given class they may be combined with another class, or class not available for that event.

Qualifier Heats

All heats will be randomly sorted and use a staggered IFMAR style start.

Wednesdays.....one 5-minute qualifier Saturdays...... two 5-minute qualifiers Sundays...... two 5-minute qualifiers

Main Races

The TQ will go to the racer with fastest single pace after qualifiers are finished. All mains are 5 minutes in length.

When more than 10 entries per class; A-main will be top 6 qualifiers and B-main will start with 7th qualifier. The top two finishers from the B-main will bump-up to the A-main.

Class Details and Rules

For All Classes (except Novice/Sportsman)

All motors must be ROAR approved and available to the general public for purchase. All classes must use 2S hard case lipo batteries (except Novice/Sportsman). Battery voltage must never exceed 8.44 volts at any time. To ensure the safety and wellbeing of our racers, spectators, and track personnel, all cars and their batteries are subject to voltage check at any time. All cars must have 4-wheel independent suspension, single speed transmissions only. No Gyros or traction control of any kind are allowed, including those built into receivers like the Spektrum AVC, Traxxas TSM, etc. See ROAR rule book, pages 49 & 50, sections 8.7.1 & 8.7.2, for all chassis rules.

Novice/Sportsman Graduation

Novice racers will graduate to Sportsman class once he/she accumulates 15 points **and** is within the 10% rule of the class he/she is graduating to i.e., Sportsmen.

- Points are based on wins:
 - 1^{st =} 3 points
 - $2^{nd} = 2$ points
 - $3^{rd} = 1$ point
- O 10% Rule: Is the slowest and the fastest times <u>Example:</u> John Doe (Novice racer) accumulated 15 points and wants to graduate to Sportsmen. The RD will review the driver times from Sportsmen, using the slowest and the fastest times to find the 10% of each. John Doe times will need to fall within the 10% of the slowest and fastest to advance.

Similarly, in Sportsman, the racer will graduate after the racer accumulates 15 points **and** is within the 10% rule of the class, will graduate to the class of their choice i.e., spec, stock, open, etc.

Note: The RD can make the ruling to graduate a driver from Novice/Sportsmen if it is clear he/she does not belong in Novice based on times.

 Motor/ESC: Any 540-size electric motor (brushed or brushless), any ESC o Encourage ROAR approved 21.5T or 17.5T brushless motors, blinky ESC • Tire: Any

- Class is intended to be a driver's class using restricted spec components for fun, close racing!
- Chassis: Limited 1/10 2wd electric off-road buggy kits o Kit must be available on open market for at least one year, no latest and greatest kits allowed. Example: 2020 xb2 available, 2019 xb2 and earlier allowed in class.
 - No modifications to lighten the drivetrain are allowed. Exception: slipper eliminators are permitted.
- Minimum Weight: 1499g
- Battery: Spec battery required o Gens Ace 2s 7.4v 3500mah hard case lipo battery
 - Part # GA2523
- Motor: Spec motor required o Hobbywing Justock 17.5T fixed timing brushless motor
 - Part # 30408011
- ESC: Spec ESC required Hobbywing Justock XR10 fixed timing brushless ESC
 - Part # 30112000
- Tires: Spec tires required o Schumacher Cactus buggy rear (yellow compound)
 - Glue Part # 6838
 - Pre-mount Part # 6839 Schumacher Cut Stagger buggy front
