*Forced Labour	*Organ Harvesting

Australia is primarily a destination country for people trafficked from Asia, particularly Thailand, Korea, the Philippines, and Malaysia. Australia's slavery, slavery-like and human trafficking offences are set out in division 270 and 271 of the **Commonwealth Criminal Code Act 1995**.

- * **Bravehearts**: phone 1800 272 831 – 8.30 am-4.30 pm, Monday to Friday aest.

***Child protection services**

- **Australian Capital Territory**

Contact act child and youth protection services on 1300 556 729 – 24 hours, 7 days a week.

- **New South Wales**

Call the child protection helpline on 132 111 – 24 hours, 7 days a week.

- **Northern Territory** call the child protection hotline on 1800 700 250 – 24 hours, 7 days a week.

- **Queensland** during normal business hours, contact Queensland regional intake services.

After hours and on weekends, contact the child safety after hours service centre on 1800 177 135 or (07) 3235 9999.

- **South Australia** call the SA child abuse report line on 131 478 – 24 hours, 7 days a week.

- **Tasmania** call the Tasmanian child safety service – advice and referral line on 1300 737 639 – 24 hours, 7 days a week.

- **Victoria** during normal business hours, contact your nearest child protection service in Victoria. After hours and on weekends, contact the after-hours child protection emergency service on 131 278.

- **Western Australia** contact WA central intake team on 1800 273 889 during normal business hours.

- Call the crisis care unit on (08) 9223 1111 or 1800 199 008 after hours and on weekends. If you are a victim of trafficking or know someone who is, contact the AFP on 131afp (131237) or use the online form to report information regarding human trafficking.
