Individual: Requests for these individuals include food, clothing and gifts. Plan to spend approximately \$50 for each veteran you request.

Veteran and Family: Families range in size from two people to larger families. If you adopt a family, we suggest that you purchase a supermarket gift certificate. You should plan to spend approximately \$50 per family member.

Please note: this is only a guideline to help you plan. Many donors spend far more and some do not spend as much.

Gift Card Donations: Many veterans need assistance with food as well as gifts. We also do not always match all of the veterans with a donor due to late nominations. Individuals or families left at the end of the program will receive a gift card for the holidays. Walmart and Amazon gift cards are the most universal.
