Terms and Conditions

ALL COMPETITORS COMPETE AT THEIR OWN RISK

- Entry into the Ute Muster does not automatically allow access to the Mareeba Rodeo event on Saturday 9th July. Tickets can be purchased online or at the gate with an extra fee.
- All competitors must have 0.0 blood alcohol level to participate divers will be breath tested.
- No camping is allowed in the Show and Shine area.
- No passengers are allowed. This is a driver only event unless required due to impairment such as hearing etc.
- All competitors must wear covered shoes. No thongs or sandals.
- Seat belts must be worn and properly adjusted during competition.
- Burnouts are prohibited.
- Show and Shine entrants can move their utes from 10am if competing in driving events as well.
- Registration of vehicle is not required BUT must be road worthy compliant as QLD Roads Traffic Authority and those not registered will be checked before the event.
- Maximum speed in and to the Show n Shine Arena is 5kph (walking speed).
- Competitors assume full responsibility and accept full liability for their own health, well-being, safety, physical actions, and the result of their actions.
- Failure to comply with the conditions of entry, rules and parking instructions will result in automatic disqualification from the competition and forfeit of the entry fee.
- Entry fee is non refundable whether you cancel in advance or on the day.
- The judge's decision is final.
- *Entries to close once capacity is reached at 20 for Barrel Racing and 20 for Circle work.*

The Committee reserves the right:

- a) To refuse any nomination for any event without giving reason for such refusal.
- b) To change the program without notice.

CAMPING – non powered sites only.

Dogs must not be let off the chain or lead at any time during an event. It is preferred that dogs not be brought to Kerribee Park.

Open Fires are not allowed

U18's are not permitted to consume alcohol anywhere on the Kerribee Park grounds, whether with a parent or not. Heavy fines can be imposed on any underage drinkers. Any BYO alcohol must be left in your vehicle or at your campsite. You can not walk around the public areas with alcohol (i.e. anywhere outside your campsite).

GLASS – Please do not bring any glass bottles onto Kerribee Park.

RUBBISH – Please ensure your campsite is clean and put all rubbish in the bins on your way out.
