# Blessed Sacrament Parish Religious Education Registration 2021 - 2022

**PLEASE READ ENTIRELY BEFORE FILLING OUT REGISTRATION FORM.**

Return the completed form to the Religious Education Office (RE) with your payment stapled to the form **due at registration** by bringing the form to the parish office or by mailing it to: Religious Education Office 1745 E. 9800 S., Sandy, 84092.

**Early registration is necessary for us to effectively plan for teachers, textbooks and classroom space. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.**

**Confirmation Program:** All eighth graders, **including Blessed Sacrament Catholic School students**, that are members of our parish and wish to be Confirmed in 2022, are required to attend the Confirmation class held on Sunday mornings from 9:45am – 10:45am and must register for religious education during the regular registration period. Blessed Sacrament parishioners enrolled in the seventh grade Religious Education program in the school year 2020-2021 and those seventh graders enrolled in Blessed Sacrament School will receive separate correspondence outlining the Confirmation program. Completion of 7<sup>th</sup> grade Religious Education curriculum or attendance in a Catholic School in 7<sup>th</sup> grade is required for acceptance to 8<sup>th</sup> grade Confirmation preparation.

**Fees:** Payment must accompany this form. Payment arrangements may be made by calling **(801) 571-5517**.

- ◆ \$70.00 per student for first 2 students K-7 and 1<sup>st</sup> year RCIA for Children. (See below for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year (First Communion, Confirmation & RCIA))
- ◆ \$100.00 per student for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Communion Class - **Religious Education Program**
- ◆ \$100.00 per student for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Confirmation Class - **Religious Education Program**
- ◆ \$50.00 per student for 8<sup>th</sup> grade Class attending **Blessed Sacrament School. (Confirmation)**
- ◆ \$25.00 per student for three or more (Non sacramental classes only)

***NO CHILD will be denied religious education based on inability to pay. Please contact the Parish Office for special rates or financial consideration.***

## **RCIA Rite of Christian Initiation for Children**

***(This class is for children 7 years old and older who have not yet received Sacraments of Initiation ~ Baptism, First Eucharist, Confirmation. Please call Blessed Sacrament prior to completing this form)***

### **Requirements:**

1. All students registering for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year First Communion or Confirmation classes must have satisfactorily completed the religious education class the year immediately preceding (1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades respectively) in a Catholic school or a Parish School of Religion (CCD). This requirement includes having had good attendance record for those classes.
  
2. **All students registering for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Sacrament classes must present a copy of their Baptismal certificate when registering.**  
If your child was baptized at Blessed Sacrament Parish, just state the month and year on this registration form.

## **Attendance:**

**Please do not sign up for classes if you do not plan on regular weekly attendance (excusing illness or family emergency).** More than 2 unexcused absences in sacrament preparation classes (**1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year classes**) may result in the student repeating the class. An unexcused absence is any absence that does not involve an illness or an unplanned and unavoidable family conflict or any absence that is not phoned into the Religious Education office.
