

- 2.9 Any Ladies rowing full-long course cannot row the ladies regular race and they are not eligible for the championship race.
- 2.10 The Rules Committee shall ensure that sufficient officials, including: timekeepers, judges, starters, etc. shall be provided for each race during the Regatta Day Programme.
- 2.11 The Rules Committee reserves the right to admit at any time prior to the Regatta, substitute(s), for any competitor(s), who through sickness or approved reasons is (are) prevented from rowing or who has (have) been rejected by the Committee as ineligible. The Rules Committee also reserves the right to receive and deal with objectives to such substitute(s).
- 2.12 No person shall be permitted to tamper with any boat including adjustment to a boat's oarlock/outrigger structure. Persons including crew members, coxswains, coaches, and/or crew managers not complying with this Rule shall result in the disqualification of that crew from its racing events.
NOTE: All such adjustments shall only be undertaken by Boat House management personnel.
- 2.13 The seat length will not exceed 11".

3. **REGATTA DAY PROGRAMME:**

- 3.1 Selection of crews for the Regatta Day Programme shall be made by the Rules Committee based on Registration.
- 3.2 The draw for boats and stakes for the Regatta Day Programme will take place for all mens' and ladies' crews entered at a date and time designated by the Rules Committee in order to determine the make-up of each race.
- 3.3 Ladies' crews will row in one race only on Regatta Day apart from those crews who qualify for the Ladies' Championship Race.
- 3.4 All crews - not just winning crews - will be eligible for their respective Championship Race.
- 3.5 Each Championship Race shall consist of the four fastest times rowed on Regatta Day. The crew making the *fastest* time during the day will take the coxswain that it rowed with, be permitted the boat, stake, and buoy of its choice; the crew making the *second fastest* time during the day will take the coxswain that it rowed with, be permitted the choice of the remaining boats, stakes, and buoys after the first crew has had its choice; the crew making the *third fastest* time during the day will take the coxswain that it rowed with, be permitted the choice of the remaining boats, stakes, and buoys following the first and second crews' choices and the crew making the *fourth fastest* time during the day will take the coxswain that it rowed with and the choice of the remaining boats, stake and buoy.
Prizes shall be awarded to all crew members competing in the mens' and ladies' Championship Races.
- 3.6 In the event that the Regatta Programme is postponed whilst in progress and is spread over several days, the resulting boat positions of all races rowed prior to the postponement shall be official. The postponed portion of the Regatta Programme shall be completed on a date and time designated by the Regatta Committee. The crews who rowed races prior to the postponement shall be given the opportunity to row special races for time only to qualify for the Championship Race is so desired.
- 3.7 All Squirts must wear CSA Approved Life Jacket at all time in boat.
