The administration will conduct a staff meeting with the teachers that will be in contact with the child, and conference with parents regarding resources available.
Migrant	Migrant students will be assisted by the Migrant Education Program. Students will be prioritized by the MEP for supplemental services based upon need and migrant status. They provide support to students and families in locating services necessary to ensure academic success of these students whose education has been interrupted by moves. We provide transportation and have translators available if needed. Teachers and administrators will conduct a home visit and express important information regarding school or academics.
