THE SHAPE OF MY FOOD

"The Shape of My Food" is a 3D art workshop reflecting on identity, culture, and unity. The families are asked to use air-dry clay and acrylics to sculpt and paint their favorite food out of their imagination or from images/samples provided. The participants usually respond with different ideas, from very complex to simple ones. In past workshops, for instance, a family originally from Mexico made tacos, tortas, conchas, and other native foods. Some children made sculptures of fast food and exotics foods as Pitaya (dragon fruit) or Morel mushrooms. The workshop then becomes like a dinner party, where people get to know each other, share stories about their traditions and what they enjoy eating, or talk about their heritage. It is a spontaneous, harmonious, and nutritive learning experience.

MAKING MODERN PRAYER FLAGS: A TIBETAN LEGACY

Tibetan prayer flags are rectangular pieces of cloth hung in high places, like mountain passes, temples, and rooftops in the Himalayan regions. They're printed with mantras, symbols, and deities to bring peace and good fortune. When the wind blows, the blessings are thought to spread. They're important for religious ceremonies and festivals in Tibetan culture. Nowadays, modern prayer flags with contemporary designs and slogans are popular worldwide, expressing support for environmental conservation, peace, and social justice. They also serve as art or decoration, spreading positivity and blessings to those who see them. They're a way to connect with Tibetan culture and philosophy and express personal values and beliefs.
