- **2.** Entry submissions will close on February 14th 2025, or sooner if all spots for the shootout are filled. Entry Fee must accompany each entry to confirm your entry. Entry Fee will be forfeited by teams not appearing to play as drawn. Substitute teams can be added if a forfeit occurs after the draw is completed.
- **3.** Nominations are limited to the first 16 teams

 The draw for the first round of the shootout will occur on the 25th of February 2025.
- **4.** Prize Money will be awarded as follows:

- **5.** The Shootout will be conducted Saturday 1st March 2025, with the first game kicking off 9am. All games will be played on Leonay Oval, Emu Plains. (Fixture Times added on last Page)
- **6.** Teams travelling may have later games requested to allow sufficient time to arrive.
- **7.** Shootout games on the Saturday will be 2 x 20-minute halves with no time off unless called by the referee for an injury. There will be a 3-minute halftime break.
- **8.** Each Team entering may nominate up to 25 players, who MUST be registered with the club that they are nominated to play with. Team Managers will need to sign a statement to this effect on the team sheet. Drawn Matches:

Round 1, Quarter Finals, and Semi Finals

In the event of a draw:

- 1. 5 minutes each way of extra time will be played.
- 2. The first team to score in this golden point period (Try, Penalty Goal, Field Goal) will be declared the winner and the game will be completed.
- 3. If the match is still drawn after this period then Golden point will continue until we have a winner.

Grand Final

In the event of a draw:

- 1. 5 minutes each way of extra time will be played in its entirety.
- 2. If the match is still drawn after this 10-minute period, then Golden point will begin until we have a winner.
