#### FINALS OVERVIEW

#### SPECTATOR ENTRY & ADDMISSION CHARGE AT FINALS VENUES

Panthers Juniors remains committed to government guidelines and sportsgrounds being accessible for sport whist ensuring the safety and well-being of all participants and the community. Our role however is to communicate social gatherings and community sport attendance guidelines and provide measures to assist any recommendations. We ask kindly to always social distance (1.5m), recommend RAT testing before arrival at any finals venue if you have signs or symptoms of Covid-19 or if you are feeling unwell with signs and symptoms of any kind of influenza, kindly stay safe and at home to prevent any further spread of any virus.

Admission charges to all final's matches are listed below. For transparency, fees cover all finals expenses listed in the introduction, including volunteer incidentals. ALL MULTI-ENTRY day passes can be purchased online only and below provides you with an understanding of where entry fees are applicable If you are paying in cash at the gate:

- Week 4 \$10, for all Division 1 Grand Finals from U9 to Open Age Competitions
- Aged Pensioners and Children U15 years of age and under are free
- PDJRL Life Members are FREE by displaying their Life Member Badge received last year
- SAVE 20% now if you pre-purchase online at Panther Juniors website or Facebook page.

#### SQUAD MEMBERS (PLAYERS AND STAFF) ENTRY AT FINALS VENUES

All teams in finals matches have a maximum participant registration number and how many can be on the sideline during a match as per our 2022 by-laws for each age group. Panthers Juniors will be providing each team with a squad member Lanyon for each registered member in the squad, Club executives will be provided with these Lanyon's for each match.

The squad member Lanyon will entitle to the person to FREE entry when the Lanyon is handed in at the gate. Please note, gate officials will be on hand to collect your squad member Lanyon and any squad member who does NOT present to the gate with a Lanyon IS required to pay the respective entry fee to enter the venue.

#### TEAM SHED ACCESS

**Saturday Rugby League**: For all finals series matches there will be no access to team sheds at half time or fulltime. These procedures are in place to ensure every team has the best experience and appropriate time to prepare for their match without disruption or anguish. Please ensure you vacate with all belongings.

**Sunday Rugby League**: For all finals series matches there will be no access to team sheds at fulltime (excluding venues with multiple shed and the last game of the day). These procedures are in place to ensure every team has the best experience and appropriate time to prepare for their match without disruption or anguish. Please ensure you vacate with all belongings.



#### FINALS OVERVIEW

#### **CLUB & TEAM STAFF COMPLIANCE**

The following officials will be required to wear the compulsory accreditation to access the field of play. No accreditations will be handed out on the day:


- President / Secretary Please maintain your U7 gala day Lanyon accreditation
- Coach / Manager Please ensure you have your club polo or hoodie on to be permitted on field
- Trainers Please ensure you collect or purchase a shirt from your club to be permitted on field
- If your official is <u>NOT</u> compliant No Entry

#### TEAM BENCH ONLY:

- 1 x Coach 1 x Manager
- 2 x Trainers for U9 to U12
- 3 x Trainers for U13 to Open age (Minimum Green to 15s Minimum Blue 16s and above)
- No Injured players, No Assistant Coach, No Physio, No Stats Person etc.

COMPLIANCE GUIDLEINES:

- Team Staff have a designated box stay within it or be ejected
- Team Staff are NOT to comment on, question or abuse match officials or their decisions
- Trainers are not to sledge, use unseemly language, walk or coach at any time on field during play
- Team Staff are not to yell or coach from the bunker under any under any circumstances





#### FINALS OVERVIEW

#### ALL SCHEDULED MATCH TIMES

For all finals series matches, if teams are not on field and ready at the exact time the match is to commence the clock will start and the match officials at their discretion will award a penalty for time delaying. The exception to the rule will only be based on a previous matches extra time or unforeseen event occurring where play cannot start for safety reasons.

#### PARTICIPATING TEAMS

Team Managers of participating teams in Finals matches can follow the following instructions to ensure the best possible and hassle-free game day experience:

- Each Manager to attend opposition warm up to cite players
- Any discrepancy please advise PDJRL Bunker official on the day
- All scoresheets will be prepared and pre-populated by Panthers Juniors with names and NRL ID
- Players and team Staff will NOT be required to sign on
- Players must be wearing the same number as listed on the scoresheet and MySideline Manager
- The clock will start at the schedule time by the Junior League official if you are not on the field the clock will commence.

#### CODE OF CONDUCT

Panthers Juniors are committed to providing a safe, welcoming and nurturing environment for all players, supporters, match officials and team officials. The Finals experience is about the children, officials and senior participants. Clubs are responsible for the conduct of their coaches, parents, supporters and players.

The NSWRL Codes of Conduct will be strictly administered and heavy suspensions and fines, including deregistration will be in place for any antisocial behaviour and teams may be stripped of awards.

Players sent off in Final matches WILL NOT be able to access the field after the match and must always remain behind the fence.

#### **GRAND FINAL PRESENTATIONS**

All Grand Finals will adhere to government and governing body guidelines. Presentations will proceed at the venue on field by the designated Junior League officials. In order of merit:

- Match Officials medals
- Grand Finalist medals
- Premiers medals
- Premiership Shield

#### POLICE & SECURITY

Both plain clothed and uniform Police from the all Local Area Commands where finals matches are held have been contacted to patrol all Junior League Finals matches, including Security and hosting Club Ground management at all venues.

#### ALCOHOL & SMOKING

No smoking or alcohol will be permitted or sold at any venue during the Finals series.



#### **BY-LAW SUMMARY**

#### VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

- 1. The use of cameras, video cameras, phone cameras or electronic/mechanical device (for film, imaging or photo) are not permitted to be used inside change rooms, the playing area that is roped, fenced or marked off at any ground under the control of the PDJRL
- 2. Selected Grand Finals will have a professional recorder at the venue with a link to purchase a professional copy

#### METHOD OF DETERMINING FINALS POSITIONS

- At the conclusion of competition matches, if two (2) or more teams are equal in competition points, then for the purpose of determining the order of placement of teams for the final series, the teams will be ranked in order, according to the difference between the number of points scored by a team and the number of points scored against a team with the team with the greater difference being ranked ahead of a team with lesser, in the event of that difference being equal, the following percentage determination will be made with the team with the highest percentage being ranked ahead of the team with the lower percentage:
  - a. Points scored x 100 divided by Points against: 200p (For) x 100 / 150p (against) = 133%
- 2. The finals series will be a Super 6 series over 3 weeks:

Week 1: 3<sup>rd</sup> Place vs 6<sup>th</sup> Place – Elimination Finals 4<sup>th</sup> Place vs 5<sup>th</sup> Place – Elimination Finals

#### Week 2:

Winner of 3<sup>rd</sup> vs 6<sup>th</sup> – Plays 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – Grand Final Qualifier Winner of 4<sup>th</sup> vs 5<sup>th</sup> – Plays 1<sup>st</sup> Place – Grand Final Qualifier

#### Week 3:

Winner of week 2 matches play in the Grand Final

#### RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLUBS HOSTING FINALS MATCHES

1. The Hosting Finals venue will be responsible for the control of spectators and supporters. If after the appropriate investigation, a club or its appointed representative is convicted of having inadequate crowd and ground management procedures in place or ignored or refused to meet the required ground management obligation, resulting in serious breach of the PDJRL rules, in addition to discipline action being taken against individuals, future finals series matches at the venue will not be allocated.

#### 2. The hosting venue is responsible to ensure the following are provided:

- Adequate PA system
- A full canteen available

Scoreboard where the venue has access to one – Time NOT to be displayed where applicable Covered area and adequate seating for official table(s) and reserve players Corner posts, goal post pads and ground/field markings with CONES, must be soft rubber Competition rule book, sign on sheets and three (3) clocks, siren or bell. First Aid Kit, Ice and receptacle for blood soiled dressings Easy access for ambulance and prompt medical contact



#### **BY-LAW SUMMARY**

#### FINALS ELIGIBILITY

- 1. To be eligible to participate in semi-finals, finals and Grand Finals in competitions administered by PDJRL, a player must have played a minimum of five (5) competition games with the club team you are registered with
- 2. In the case of a player not being able to play the required five (5) matches as indicated above due to injury sustained during the season or other incident outside of a match, upon investigation of medical evidence by the GM, such player may be permitted to take part in a final's series match. Adequate medical proof (medical certificate) is required to be submitted to the GM within fourteen (14) days of the incident (injury)
- 3. Any player that qualifies for a final's series match in their registered age group, and the age group above is not more than 1 year above their actual age, automatically qualifies for the older age groups finals series without playing a competition match
- 4. Washout matches are included if you were registered prior to any washout and your team was scheduled to play on that weekend
- 5. If a team requires players to play up an age or up a division, the limit is three (3) players per match and any player may not participate for a secondary team at the expense of registered players to that team as their primary team
- 6. A player that qualifies for a final's series in their registered team, and the age group or division above is higher and not more than 1 year above their actual age group, the player automatically qualifies for the older age group or division finals series without playing a competition match.
- 7. A player may play in a match prior to or after their primary teams' fixture

#### TIME KEEPING PROCEDURES

- 1. During Semi-finals and finals only, all team mangers will continue to fulfil their role at the official table and time keep as you would as per any competition round. With the addition of time off in each half or quarter
- 2. Time Keeping for Grand Finals will be controlled by the PDJRL official

#### TEAMS NOT READY AT KICK OFF

1. The clock will start at the scheduled match time

#### INTERCHANGE

- 1. PDJRL does not apply the national guideline '3-minute rule' for interchanges in Mini and Mod Rugby League
- 2. PDJRL does not permit a player to be replaced in the first period of a match for Mini/Mod fixtures. If a player is replaced in the first period, injured or not the player may not return to the field for the remainder of the match
- 3. International fixtures have a maximum of 10 interchanges per match and changes at half-time are included in the total number of changes





#### BY-LAW SUMMARY

#### DRAWN MATCHES DURING FINALS SERIES

1. When the scores are equal after the completion of any play-off, semi-final, final or grand final the referee will call the two captains together and advise that the game will go into extra time of two 5-minute periods for Junior Rugby League games (Under 9 to Opens). A coin toss will give one of the team captains the option of either kicking off in extra-time or receiving the ball from the kick-off. The game will re-commence and continue until one of the teams scores:

» In Junior Rugby League (Under 9s to Under 12s), a try or
» In International Football (Under 13s to Open Age), either a field goal, penalty goal or a try.

The referee will then immediately terminate the game with the team scoring first declared the winner

- 2. If neither team has scored at the conclusion of the first period of extra-time, the teams will change ends and the game will recommence with a kick-off from half-way.
- 3. In semi-finals and finals, in the event that neither team has scored following two periods of 5 minutes of extra-time, the team who scored the first 'TRY' will be declared the winner and will progress to the next round of the final's series.
- 4. In Grand Finals, in the event that neither team has scored following two periods of 5 minutes of extra time, the game will be declared a draw with both team's joint premiers.
- 5. Teams with limited interchange, an additional (2) players will be available in the extra time periods.

#### PROTESTS DURING FINALS SERIES

- 1. Should a protest occur during or immediately after a play-off, semi-final, final or Grand Final every effort will be made to resolve the issue at the venue as soon as possible.
- 2. Should a protest be unable to be resolved at the venue, all protests will be heard if possible on the day of the match, at a time and venue to be advised by the GM. Any protest shall be immediately referred to the GM who will arrange an urgent hearing.
- 3. For a protest to be accepted from Clubs involved in the final series matches it must be lodged in writing at the official table, no later than fifteen (15) minutes after the completion of the game. The GM may institute action regarding a breach of PDJRL rules at any time.
- 4. The GM is authorised to investigate all protests, complaints and other concerns and make adjudication. This may be done by involving a match review committee should that be desired.

#### ABANDONED END OF SEASON FINALS MATCHES

- Because of the significantly increased profile of the end of series matches and the privilege of being involved, the PDJRL Board expects players and team support officials to place emphasis on the need to respect and support the NSWRL Codes of Conduct and good behaviour rules during these matches
- Should a play-off, semi-final, final or Grand Final be abandoned, due to the pressing need to conclude an investigation before the following weekend, the PDJRL Manager shall obtain reports from both teams, match and ground officials and other appropriate persons and cause an immediate investigation to be carried out into the reasons and reported to the NSWRL for an adjudication


