


LUKE LEWIS CUP

WEIGHT FOR AGE COMPETITION



Panthers Juniors is proud to lead the way as the first junior rugby league district in Australia to run a Weight-for-Age competition. This groundbreaking initiative has been approved by NSWRL and is designed to create a fairer and safer playing environment by matching young athletes based on both their age and weight.

- WHO CAN PLAY: Any child in the Under 12 age group including those already registered in the PDJRL for Saturday competitions, as well as those not currently playing. Out of district players not playing in 2025 can play in the comp
- **WEIGHT:** The weight to be eligible is under 50kg and 11 year olds can get a one year dispensation if they wish to play.
- WHO CAN NOT PLAY: Out of district registered players for 2025 season.
- WHEN: Held on Sundays, running for up to 8 weeks plus a finals series.
- **COST:** No registration fees are required.
- **PLAYING KIT:** Players will be issued a Panthers Juniors playing kit including the logo of their host club on the jersey.
- **VENUES:** Games will be held at one central venue each Sunday, rotated between the host club

RECORD FEMALE REGISTRATIONS



History-Making Season in the Making as Panthers Juniors Near 2,000 Registered Female Players

Panthers Juniors has officially shattered its all-time female registration record, with 1,958 girls signed up for the 2025 season, and counting. This marks a staggering 19.03% increase from the previous record of 1,645, and up 27.3% more than this time last year. All signs point to continued momentum until registrations close June 30.

Coming off a groundbreaking 2024 season in which Panthers Juniors became the first district to implement on-age female competitions, it's clear that growth has carried strongly into 2025. This was further complimented with the extension of Coates' partnership with all Panthers Juniors Female Competitions in the 2025 season.

The impact of the on-age competitions is already being felt. New female competitions have emerged in 2025 that didn't exist just a year ago. One of the standout examples is the creation of a nine-team Under 17 Girls competition, a clear sign of expanding participation and opportunity.





RECORD FEMALE REGISTRATIONS



"The energy around girls' footy in Penrith has never been stronger," said Kylie Fitzpatrick, Female Pathways Operations Manager. "We're coming off the back of our most successful Lisa Fiaola and Tarsha Gale seasons in recent history, with both squads winning in Week 1 of the finals before narrowly bowing out in the semi-finals."

With the Harvey Norman Women's Premiership season still to come, the Panthers Juniors community is buzzing with anticipation, and the pathway from grassroots to elite has never looked more exciting.

Panthers Juniors has seen growth in every age group and it is great to see an increase in female participation as young as 4-9 years old. Rugby League is a sport for all and is great to see more parents choosing to place their daughters in Rugby League over other sports.

Much of the growth in 2025 is being driven by players in the 10–15-year-old age bracket, where the district has seen over 180 new registrations in 2025 alone. This surge indicates a solid foundation being laid for future female pathway success in Penrith and beyond.

"Our goal is to create an environment where every girl, whether she's lacing up boots for the first time or aspiring for a career in Rugby League, feels like she belongs," South added. "We're seeing more returning players, more sisters joining, and more families getting involved in the women's game. That tells us the game is growing, but also that as a district, including all volunteers, coaches clubs and staff, that we are doing something right."
