The most influential Penrith and Districts Junior Rugby League Female figure in its history who also served the district for over 35 years before her passing.

Jan Cameron left a legacy of the highest order on work ethic, integrity and passion for Rugby League administration and the development and welfare of players. The attributes of Jan are reflected in the game today and are continually referred to and discussed by all clubs on how Jan delivered her craft.

Jan Cameron's contribution to Rugby League benefitted many sectors, Jan:

- * Born in Western Sydney then moved to Western Australia and contributed to starting Rugby League in that state
- * Moving to Sydney, Jan governed the Katoomba Club for many a year as secretary
- * Jan became a Vice President within the Penrith and Districts Junior League Management team and subsequently on her intelligence and passion was a short time thereafter elected to the Penrith and Districts Junior Rugby League Board.
- * Jan had a significant contribution in building the stature of young men and women in Rugby League within our district and passionate in wanting Women to have an active involvement in Rugby League whether as a coach, trainer, manager and more importantly as administrators of our game.
