

#### GET TO KNOW ME Duck Man

The Panthers Junior RL competition has been back up and running for 3 weeks now this 2024 season, and for a local boy like me who grew up at Cambo and Windsor, the opportunity to come on board and commentate every week this season has been an outstanding opportunity that I relish.

This season is my first year dipping the toe into the Rugby League commentary waters after being one of the Lead commentators in NSW Rugby union for the last 4 years covering Shute Shield games, women's rugby games and suburban rugby matches too.

- Who are you and what is your rugby league background?
  - My name is Matt Austin
  - My nickname is the Duck Man
  - I'm 46 now and began playing rugby league back at Werrington Public School in PSSA in year 3 in 1986 and mainly played school footy at Werrington Public School throughout primary school, Cambridge Park High School for a couple of years and Windsor High School and I spent a season at Cambo in 2000 when Craig Izzard was coaching playing reggies.

- I used to support Parra until 1986 then started going for the Panthers in 1987 because I was living in Cambo and going to school with kids in the area, and they were all local blokes that I looked up to like MG and Brandy.
- I've wanted to be a football commentator since I was 9 and really liked guys like Rex the Moose Mossop, Graeme Hughes, Ray Hadley and Ray Warren.





# FROM THE REFERS




#### WHY ARE THERE DIFFERENT COLOURED LINES ON THE FIELD?

Have you noticed in senior footy this year that at grounds the 40m line is marked with red or a different colour paint to the rest of the lines?

This is to assist the match officials identify a couple of things. When a team plays the ball on or beyond their own 40m line ruck and 10m infringements change from penalties to set restarts. Having the visual cue help the match officials in these situations and they also use this for general play kicks.

This is to identify when a team kicks in general play from within 40m of their own goal and the ball enters touch beyond their opponents 20m line (30m line in u18 girls & open women's) they will receive the ball back by way of a tap kick restart 20m in from touch no closer than 10m to the oppositions goal line.

This restart cannot be taken quick and must be only taken after the referee blows their whistle.


