## WOMEN'S FOOTY IN 2024



Panthers Juniors has seen nearly 1,500 female registrations in 2024 thus far - a record breaking figure contributing to a rise of 33% YTD.

In a bid to continue the increase of female participation in rugby league, Panthers Juniors is set to be the first Junior League District in the world to host on age female competitions, beginning in 2024.

In 2024 Panthers Juniors female competitions will look as follows:

U10, U12, U13, U14, U15, U16, U18, & Open Womens - as well as many girls playing in mixed competitions.

Panthers Juniors General Manager Blake South is pleased to be making the move to grow the women's game.

"Moving to the on age format will be a great opportunity for the girls to promote equality across female rugby league," South said.

"With the growth over the last few years we believe now is the time to attract girls lost to other sporting codes and attract new participants."

# FROM THE REFEREES



### HOW TIME FLIES, WE ARE AT THE BEGINNING OF ANOTHER JUNIOR LEAGUE SEASON.

This year sees a new opportunity for our members to succeed across the season grades. With the introduction of new laws and interpretations to streamline with NSWRL competitions.

This is an exciting challenge for our members, for members who have refereed for years, it is a change from what they have always done. For our referees who are seeking to get selected for the NSWRL Development Referees Squad at the end of the year it is an opportunity to begin officiating with the laws & interpretations they will use in their competitions.

The main changes coming into effect this year in 17s & above:

- Set restarts instead of penalties when beyond yardage (on or past your own 40m line) for ruck and 10m/marker infringements.
- Roll ball When a player fails to make a genuine attempt to play the ball with their foot it will result in a handover not a penalty.
- Scrum/PTB position in most instances the team will be allowed to move the scrum or PTB to 10m or 20m in from touch or in centre field.







# FROM THE REFEREES



 Contested kick off/Drop out – If there is a kick off/drop out that can be contested by both teams and the ball fails to travel the required distance or goes out on the full, it will result in a handover instead of a penalty. If the kick cannot be contested and goes out on the full it will still be a penalty.

Although we would love to get every decision correct, we know we will not, and we will not shy away from this fact. But before you consider criticising us, have you thought about picking up the whistle and giving it a crack? Or do you know the Laws book from cover to cover? Why not express your interest in becoming a referee via the QR code.
