

WHO WE ARE

This privacy policy applies to All In The Details, a Prairieville-based company. This privacy policy will explain how our organization uses the personal data we collect from you when you use our Website.

PRIVACY NOTICE

Our Privacy Policy was last updated on May 6, 2023.

We use your data to provide and improve allinthedetails.us (“Website”). By using our Website, you agree to the collection and use of your personal information under this Privacy Policy.

This privacy notice discloses our privacy policies and practices for our Website. The privacy notice applies solely to information collected by this Website. It will notify you of the following:

1. Which personal information is collected from you via the Website, how that information is used, and with whom that information may be shared.
2. The choices that are available to you regarding the use of your data.
3. All security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
4. The ways by which you may correct inaccuracies in the information.

DEFINITIONS

“Account” means an individual account created for you to access our Service or parts of our Service.

“Company” (referred to as either “the Company,” “We,” “Us,” or “Our” in this Agreement) refers to All In The Details.

“Country” refers to United States.

“Cookies” are small files placed on Your computer, mobile device, or any other device by a website, containing the details of Your browsing history on that Website among its many uses.

“Device” means any device that can access our Website, such as a computer, a cell phone, or a digital tablet.

“Do Not Track” (“DNT”) is a concept that has been promoted by U.S. regulatory authorities (in particular, the U.S. Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”)), for the Internet industry to develop and implement a mechanism for allowing Internet users to control the tracking of their online activities across websites.

“Personal Data” is any information related to an identified or identifiable individual.

“Service” refers to the Website.

“You” means the individual accessing or using our Website, or the Company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using our Website, as applicable.

INFORMATION COLLECTION, USE, AND SHARING

We collect the following data:

- Personal identification information, such as name, email address, phone number, etc.
- Other information such as: business name, date of event, event start and end date, event address, type of celebration, balloon garland choice, rental items and quantity, and any other information you freely provide.

We are the only owners of all information collected on and by this Website. We shall only have access to or collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct forms of contact from you. We will not sell or rent your information to anyone.

We will use your information to respond to you regarding the reason you contacted us. We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization except as necessary to fulfill your request (for example, to ship an order).

Please note that, unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via email in the future to inform you about specials, new products or services, or changes to this privacy policy.

COMPANY’S USE OF INFORMATION

The Company may use your information for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our Service**, including monitoring our Service’s usage.
- **To manage your Account**: to manage your registration as a service user. The personal data you provide can give you access to different Service functionalities that are available to you as a registered user.
- **For the performance of a contract**: the development, compliance, and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items, or services you have purchased or of any other contract with us through the Service.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy and your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to treat your data securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. No transfer of your personal data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place, including the security of your data and other personal information.

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, your data may be transferred. We will provide notice before your data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Law enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose your personal data if so required by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., a court or a government agency).

The Company may disclose your personal data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:
