Dear Heavenly Father,

On this day we remember Jesus stepping into the Jordan River, choosing to stand with us in all our humanity. As the waters closed around him and opened again, you spoke words of deep tenderness: "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased." We gather now longing to hear those words spoken over us, too.

Speak to us again, O God. Call us Your beloved. Let Your Spirit rest on us as gently as a dove, reminding us that before we accomplish anything, before we succeed or fail, we belong to You.

We pray for the courage to follow Jesus into the waters of new beginnings.

Where we are weary, renew us.
Where we are uncertain, guide us.
