- 1. Rodeo Announcer 4 performances 2 arenas running simultaneously.
 - a. Thursday Youth Rodeo Timed & Rough Stock Events June 15th,2023
 - b. Friday night open show rodeo June 16th,2023
 - c. Saturday morning slack June 17th,2023
 - d. Saturday night open show rodeo June 17th, 2023
- 2. Rodeo Funny Man 2 performances
 - a. Friday open show rodeo June 16^{th,} 2023
 - b. Saturday open show rodeo June 17th, 2023
- 3. Wooly Riding & Steer Riding Series- 3 performances each, dates TBD (April/May)
 - a. Steer Riding Stock Contractor (stock for Series at open show Friday & Saturday)
 - b. 2 Rodeo Judges
 - c. 2 bull fighters
- 4. Additional personnel
 - a. Rodeo secretary/CES for youth and open show. Mail and Walk in entries prior to events, check ins, payouts.
 - b. Rodeo timers for both rough stock & timed events.
 - c. Club or organization for parking
 - d. Photographer for all events.

5. Rodeo Stock Contractor

Gallup Lions club invites responsible offerors to provide rodeo stock and necessary personnel for the annual rodeo. After review and evaluation by our Rodeo board in a fair and advantageous process the contract will be awarded.

- a. This contract will be awarded for a two-year term
- b. Rodeo stock must be available for Timed events & Rough stock as the Rodeo runs 2 arenas simultaneously, timed events in west arena, rough stock in east arena at Red Rock Park.
- c. Any contract that may result from proposals must specify that the primary contactor is solely responsible for fulfillment of the contract with the Lions club. The club will make payments only to the primary contractor.
- d. Sub-contractors, use of subcontractors is at the discretion of the of the primary contractor as they will be wholly responsible for the entire performance.
- e. Offerors may submit with proposals any additional terms and conditions that is expected and to have included in the contract, which maybe the subject of negotiation.
- f. Offerors only submit one proposal and may attach additional materials.
- g. The offeror must include experience of the organization as well as quality and quantity of stock.
- h. Offeror must provide all necessary rodeo stock for the following events for open show
 - 1. Bareback
 - 2. Calf Roping
 - 3. Breakaway
 - 4. Saddle Bronc
 - 5. Steer Wrestling
 - 6. Open Team Roping
 - 7. Incentive Team roping
 - 8. Bullriding
 - 9. Ladies Steer riding
 - 10. Masters Bull riding
 - 11. Jr Bull riding

All events for the Youth Rodeo with room for negotiation for separate contractors if offeror is unable to provide Sheep or Goats.

- 1. Wooly riding 6 and under
- 2. Goat Tying for ages 7-9 and 10-13
- 3. Calf riding ages 7-9
- 4. Steer riding ages 10-12
- 5. Breakaway ages 10-13 and 14-17
- 6. Team roping 14-17 (12 teams in 2022)
- 7. Family Team roping (22 teams in 2022)

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6. The Gallup Lions club will have 4 performances to be held at Red Rock State Park the dates of Thursday June 15th for the Youth Rodeo time TBD. Friday June 16th Open Show performance at 7:00pm. Saturday June 17th for Morning Slack at 9:00am and Saturday evening Open show performance at 7:00pm. There may be other events held in connections with the performances so in order to coordinate the program, contractor and Lions club board will meet no less than 30 days prior before the first performance.

All offer proposals must be received no later than 5:00pm Tuesday February 28th, 2023. Evaluation of proposals will be made by the rodeo board and finalists will be notified.
