Please Initial all items: 1. The Foster Home agrees to house and care for Dane(s) belonging to NCGDRNE until a safetime is found. The Foster Home understands and agrees that NCGDRNE. is the sole and rightful wher of the foster dog(s), and that the length of each dogs stay is dependent on the dog and the ork required for rehoming 2. The Foster Home fully agrees and understands that all decisions regarding the ane(s) will be made by NCGDRNE representative and may take time to receive an answer dependent on the circumstances.
3. The Foster Home agrees to treat the Dane in a humane and loving way at all times, and to ake sure that anyone temporarily caring for the Dane will be known to NCGDRNE. (ie vacations)
4. The Foster Home understands that NCGDRNE is not responsible for any damage caused be Dane while in foster care. The Foster Home accepts liability for any and all incidents that occur is connection with the fostering of a NCGDRNE Dane. Foster Home agrees to confine the Dane in the afest manner for the individua dog, this could be a crate, gate or instill the use of a water drinkable nuzzle on the Dane in an appropriate space when it is required and when they cannot be directly upervised.
5. Crate training is preferred for NCGDRNE foster Danes. If a Dane is not crate trained when ducted into the foster care system, the Foster Home should work with the Dane to acclimatize it the crate using positive training methods. NCGDRNE will try to provide crates to any foster home at needs one. Crates will either transfer to dogs new home or back to the rescue.
6. The Foster Home agrees to provide the Dane (and all other animals he/she owns) with roper veterinary care as is recommended by NCGDRNE. Routine vet care covered by NCGDRNE cludes such services as vaccinations and preventative care. All vet appointments must be pre-aproved by NCGDRNE. Expenditures incurred by the Foster Home without prior approval by NCG-RNE are the sole responsibility of the foster family. All bills for reimbursement, together with a conteted expense report and original veterinary paperwork, should be mailed to NCGDRNE mailing ddress or northerngdrne@gmail.com
7. The Foster Home understands that if it decides it wants to adopt the Dane permanently, it

8. Foster Home agrees to return this dog to a representative of NCGDRNE within 24 hours of being asked to return the dog. If Foster home is unavailable at the time the dog is needed, Foster Home agrees to make the dog available for pick up within the 24-hour period.
9. Should the Foster Home request removal of the Dane from their home for any reason other than bodily harm to a member of the Foster Home, the Foster Home must be prepared to keep the Dane until suitable lodging can be arranged. It may not be possible for NCGDRNE to arrange lodgings for the Dane for several days.
10. No foster Dane is to be removed or transported out of state or country without written approval by NCGDRNE.
11. All materials/objects/supplies including but not limited to forms, collars, crates, etc. provided to the volunteer /oster (for events/foster/volunteer purposes) will be returned within 48 hours of NCGDRNE asking for them, unless other arrangments ae agreed upon
The dog may be confused when you first work with him/her, but with patience, consis tency, and reassurance, he/she should readily adapt to the routine of the home. I, the Foster, understand that NCGDRNE is whom I am signing this contract with.
The parties hereby acknowledge that they have read this entire Agreement and understand its terms and conditions and agree to be bound by same.
