


## The Christopher Columbus Status in the City of White Plains

We will continue our annual Lodge tradition commemorating Columbus Day that has spanned over 100 years on October 8 at 10:00 am at Tibbets Park on North Broadway in White Plains, NY. The statue has now been designated as an historical landmark on North Broadway. The Preservation Commission member and former City councilman Larry Delgado was an instrumental contributor to securing the statues new legal status. The statue is a beautiful marble statue and base carved in Carrara, Italy under the direction of sculptor Peter Celi of the Bronx. It was commissioned in 1913 at the cost of \$3000 which was raised by Italian residents of the then village of White Plains. We can only imagine the pride they must have felt when the Monument was dedicated in 1915. Because of Columbus, immigrants, first from Europe and then from all over the world, sought political and religious freedom, economic opportunities and a better life in America. We remember and cannot forget the hardships, discrimination, injustice and stereotyping faced by early Italian immigrants.

We hope you all can join us as we celebrate our heritage and stand up and say you are proud to be Italian.



Amonio Meurei was born in Florence on April 13, 1808, the eldest of nine children, Meucei began his academic carear at the Florence Academy of Fine Aris at the age of 15 and eventually came to be a stage designer and technician at the Testive della Perspota in Florence. It was bere that he created an account pipe telephone that could be used to communicate between the stage and the control room at the opera house.

He and his write later moved to Cults where he construed to work with instructions moveling electricity, both for the thenier world and beyond. His work included electroplating for the Army and using electrical impulses for pain relief. It was through this latter motioned work he discovered the "electrophomic" effect which eventually led him to designing the "telegrato purlante" or talking telegraph.

In 1850, Mesocs and his wife settled in Staten beland, NY where he would set up a browery, with his littend Giuseppe Garibaldi, and a tallow candle factory. However, he never loss interest in working with electricity and electrical innovations, and by 1856 he had crusted a system to communicate through wires, which was useful as he could speak with his mould wife who was in a separate part of the house from where he worked. From 1856 to 1870 he created more than 30 telephone prototypes. Then, in 1871 he applied for a patent for his now-called "sound belograph", however a failure to mention electromagnetic transmission of vocal sound on the petient caused it to lappe in 1874 and be taken by Alexander Giraham Bell.

The legacy of Antonio Meucei must never be forgotten. He is a probific and brilliant inventor who had his hand in various inventions and a man who can stand in the Partition of all great Italian inventors and thinkers.
