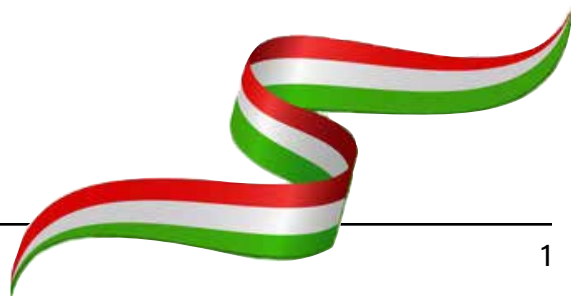

Guidelines for Honorary Members

- Any member who was initiated prior to January 1st, 2023 are considered Grandfathered and would be exempt from paying any dues when they turn 85 years of age. They will now be considered an Honorary member, and the Lodge will continue to pay the Grand Lodge Per Capita Tax for these members.
- The year that the Grandfather member turns 85 years of age they will no longer have to pay their dues. For example if the Grandfather member turns 85 years of age either in the month of January or June of the current year they will no longer pay any dues, however the Lodge will continue to pay their Per Capita Tax for these members.
- Any member who was initiated after January 1, 2023 and who were already 85 years of age or who will turn 85 years will pay 1 year of the regular amount of the Lodge's dues from their initiation date, than after that the member would only be responsible to pay the Grand Lodge Per Capita Tax amount going forward and would still be considered an Honorary member.

Fall Bocce Tournament



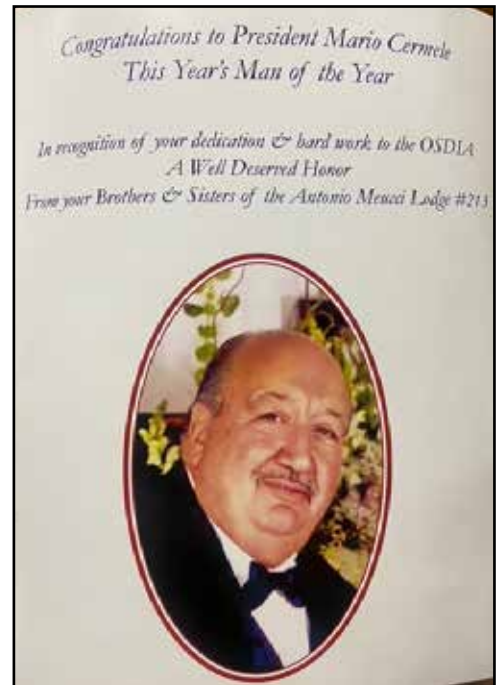

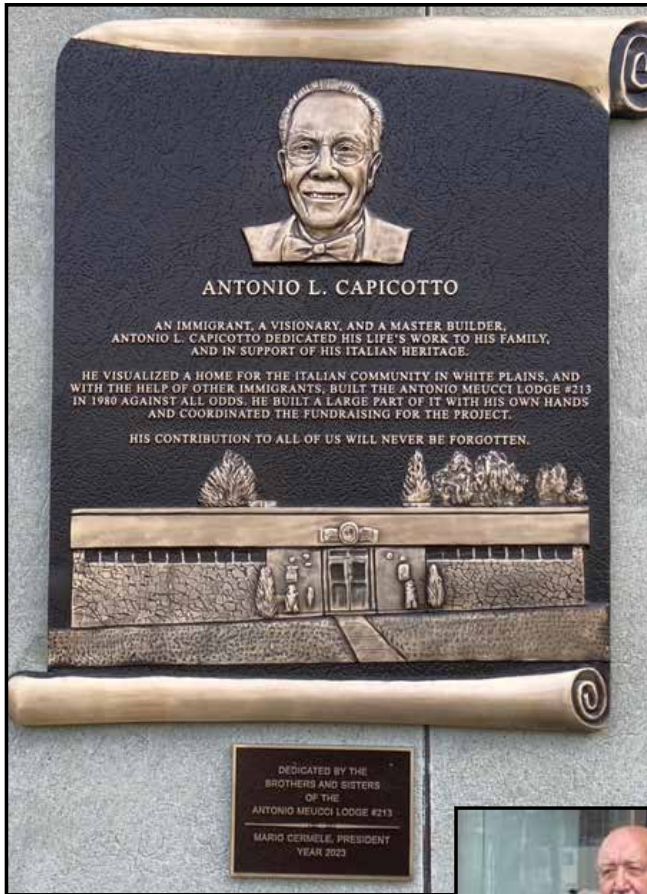
Man of the Year

Grand Lodge Scholarships of New York

In addition the Grand Lodge Order Sons & Daughters of Italy in America has their own Scholarships that students can apply to. Please note their deadline is March 31, 2024

Eligibility: Applicant must be of Italian descent and a resident of New York State. Undergraduate and graduate awards are presented to high school or college students who will begin full-time study for the fall academic term of the year their application is eligible to apply for competition. The scholarship awards are based on academic excellence and service. Students must have an average of 85% or above to apply.

This year the NY State Grand Lodge has also established a Vocational/ Trade school scholarship award.

Application Deadline: Applications and all supportive materials **must be postmarked no later than March 31 2024.**

Application Fee: An application fee of \$10.00, made payable to the NYSOSIA Grand Lodge Foundation, Inc. must be included with each application. For applications for the State Scholarships please visit the Antonio Meucci Lodge website www.antoniomeuccilodge.com/forms to download the forms

ANTONIO MEUCCI


Antonio Meucci was born in Florence on April 13, 1808, the eldest of nine children. Meucci began his academic career in the Florence Academy of Fine Arts at the age of 15 and eventually came to be a stage designer and technician at the Teatro della Pergola in Florence. It was here that he created an acoustic pipe telephone that could be used to communicate between the stage and the control room at the opera house.

He and his wife later moved to Cuba where he continued to work with innovations involving electricity, both for the theater world and beyond. His work included electroplating for the Army and using electrical impulses for pain relief. It was through this latter mentioned work he discovered the "electrophonic" effect which eventually led him to designing the "telegrafo parlante" or talking telegraph.

In 1850, Meucci and his wife settled in Staten Island, NY where he would set up a brewery, with his friend Giuseppe Garibaldi, and a tallow candle factory. However, he never lost interest in working with electricity and electrical innovations, and by 1856 he had created a system to communicate through wires, which was useful so he could speak with his invalid wife who was in a separate part of the house from where he worked. From 1856 to 1870 he created more than 30 telephone prototypes. Then, in 1871 he applied for a patent for his now-called "sound telegraph", however a failure to mention electromagnetic transmission of vocal sound on the patent caused it to lapse in 1874 and be taken by Alexander Graham Bell.

The legacy of Antonio Meucci must never be forgotten. He is a prolific and brilliant inventor who had his hand in various inventions and a man who can stand in the Pantheon of all great Italian inventors and thinkers.
