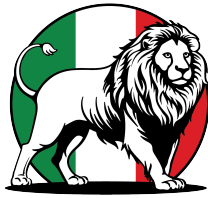

If someone guesses correctly, they earn a point, single play continues until one player reaches three points. If no-one guesses correctly, hands are thrown again immediately.
