ITALY'S CELEBRATED HOLIDAYS, EVENTS and RELIGIOUS FESTIVALS

April

Settimana Santa (Holy Week) (Leading to April 5): Intense processions occur nationwide, particularly in Sicily and the South.

April 3rd: Good Friday: The Pope leads a torchlit Stations of the Cross procession at the Colosseum in Rome

April 5th: Easter Sunday (Pasqua): Marked by the Scorpio del Carro (Explosion of the Cart) in Florence's Piazza del Duomo and major Papal Mass in St. Peter's Square

April 6th: Easter Monday (Pasquetta) A public holiday traditionally spent with family/friends picnicking in the countryside

April 21st: Natale di Roma Celebrates the founding of Rome with historical parades and fireworks

April 25th: St. Mark's Day (Festa di San Marco) Celebrated in Venice with a boat race (Regata di Traghetti) and religious processions honoring the City's patron Saint. It's also Liberation Day (Festa della

Liberation, a National holiday marking the end of WWII, featuring parades, concerts and ceremonies

April 28th-29th: Saint Biagio Celebration, which features religious processions, fireworks, and street fairs.

May

May 1st- 4th: Sagra di Sant'Efisio, Cagliari, Sardinia One of Italy's largest, most continuous religious processions, featuring thousands in traditional costume to honor the Saint who saved the city from plague

May 1: (Labour Day/May Day) A national public holiday, with rallies and a large concert in Rome near the Basilica of San Giovanni in Laterano.

Sensa (Ascension Day, Venice): A religious/civic festival recreating Venice's "marriage" to the sea with a massive boat procession

Calendimaggio (Early May, Assisi): A dramatic medieval re-enactment celebrating spring with parades, music, and competitions between the town's two, factions.

Feast of San

Fortunato (Second Sat/Sun of May, Camogli): Honors the Patron Saint of fishermen, featuring a large fish fry in 28-ton pans.

Infiorata di Noto (Mid-May, Sicily): A stunning flower petal festival where streets are covered in intricate, religiously, themed, designs.

May 15th: Festa dei Ceri An ancient, intense race, with enormous, wooden, towers, carried, by, locals, to, honor, Saint, Ubaldo.

June

June 2nd: Festa della Repubblica A national holiday celebrating the birth of the Italian Republic with military parades, particularly in Rome.

June 13th: Feast of St Anthony of Padua The patron saint of lost items, travelers, and the poor. The day is marked by special masses, the blessing of bread and processions

June 16th: Luminara di San Ranieri (Pisa): Thousands of candles light up the banks of the Arno River to honor the patron Saint of Pisa.

June 24th: San Giovanni (Feast of Saint John the Baptist): Celebrated nationwide, but highlights include fireworks and boat parades on Lake Como and in Florence.

June 29th: Saints Peter and Paul (Rome): A significant holiday in Rome, featuring special religious services and fireworks, marking the city's patron saints.

CULTURAL CLASSROOM



BIOGRAFIA FILIPPO MAZZEI

1730-1816

A Florentine physician, merchant, and intellectual whose adventurous life connected Europe and early America. After traveling widely and befriending figures like Benjamin Franklin, he moved to Virginia, bringing Tuscan farmers, agricultural ideas, and Enlightenment writings, and became close to leaders such as George Washington and Thomas Jefferson. Mazzei supported the American Revolution, influenced ideas about equality later echoed in founding documents, and served as Virginia's ambassador in Paris while interacting with key figures of the French Revolution. A cosmopolitan thinker and cultural bridge between Europe and the United States, he spent his later years in Pisa writing memoirs, remembered as a worldly Enlightenment figure who helped spread American ideals in Europe.



TRAVELTROPEA

Tropea is a beautiful seaside town in southern Calabria, famous for its dramatic cliffs, turquoise waters, and charming historic streets. Travelers are drawn to its sandy beaches and the stunning hilltop views of the Tyrrhenian Sea. One of the town's most iconic sights is the picturesque Sanctuary of Santa Maria dell'Isola, a monastery perched on a rocky cliff overlooking the sea. Pizza Rustica

Ingredients:

The Dough (Can use 2 Store Bought Pie Crusts)

- 2 ½ Cups of Flour
- ½ Cup Cold Butter- Cubed
- 2 tbsp. Olive Oil
- 1 Egg
- 1 tsp. Salt
- 4 tbsp. Cool Water

The Filling

- 7 oz. Prosciutto di Parma – Cut Into Cubes
- 8 oz. Hot Sopressata – Cut into Cubes
- 10 oz. Mild Provolone – Cut into Cubes
- 2 lbs. Cheese and Parsley Sausage- Out of the casing
- 8 oz. Fresh Mozzarella- Cut in Cubes
- 3 Cups Fresh Ricotta
- 1 ½ Tsp. Pepper
- ½ tsp. Salt
- 1 Cup Grated Pecorino Romano
- 1 Tbsp. Chopped Parsley
- 8 Eggs – beaten, plus one extra eggs for brushing on the pie
- 9 inch Springform Pan

NOTE

****Ask the deli person to slice prosciutto, hot sopressata and provolone thick (about ¼ inch thick). Then cut the meat into tiny cubes.

****A quality store bought pie dough is just as good as this homemade one.. Just roll it out to the same diameter as you would with the homemade dough.

The Dough

In a food processor fitted with a blade add the flour, butter, olives oil, egg and salt and pulse until the mixture resembles coarse sand. Then add in the water. And pulse until it is combined. Place the dough on a clean, floured countertop and knead slightly. You want to incorporate the

ingredients but not overwork it. Form into a ball, cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate for at least an hour. Just before using, take it out and bring to room temperature for 20 minutes.

For the Filling

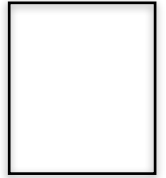
Preheat the oven to 350°. In a large skillet cook the sausage until it is no longer pink and slightly browned. Let it cool. In a bowl combine the prosciutto, hot sopressata, provolone, sausage, mozzarella, ricotta, salt, pepper, Pecorino, parsley and eggs. Mix so that all the ingredients are well incorporated. Spray your springform pan well with non-stick spray. On a flat surface put some flour. Cut ⅔ of the dough from the ball and form into another ball. Take the remaining 1/3 of the dough and make it a ball as well. Roll out the larger pie crust to about 15 inches in diameter. Transfer the dough to the springform pan. Gently push the dough so that it lines the entire bottom of the pan and up along the edges. Spoon the ricotta mixture into the dough-lined pan. Roll out the remaining piece of dough into a 10 inch round and cut into at least 15 thin strips. Then make a criss cross pattern on top of the pizza rustica. Or you can simply place the whole piece of dough right on top. Be sure to cut any excess off from around the perimeter of the pan. And crimp the edges close. In a bowl beat an egg. Use a pastry brush to coat the entire top of the pizza rustica with the egg. Put in the oven and bake for about 1 hour and 20 minutes. Allow to cool and serve.
