Bromborough, Eastham & New Ferry Monthly Update

Burglaries:

On date 1/12/2021 a Burglary was committed in Eastham where unknown offenders smashed windows to a house, gaining entry and stealing cash.

Following this on 2/12/2021 a burglary took place at a business premises in Bromborough where offenders gained entry and stole electrical goods.

7/12/2021 Burglary took place in New Ferry where an xbox was stolen.

8/12/2021 offenders forced entry to an address in Bromborough and gold items were stolen.

14/12/2021 burglary of address in Bromborough, car keys and car stolen.

21/12/2021 Burglary at an address in Spital, offenders removed window to gain

access and stole money from address while elderly victim was inside.

02/12/2021 motorbike stolen Eastham Rake.
No other thefts of motor vehicles.
Violence and Robbery
23/12/2021 Two males fighting resulted in one sustaining injuries to his head

consistent with grievous bodily harm.

Clearly the area suffered a spike in burglaries during December, a common trend on the run up to Christmas. We did however engage in a lot of crime prevention work to reduce these types of offences and the lack of robberies shows this. In an ideal

world with more staff, we could have prevented some of these burglaries but has taken its toll on increasing sickness within Bebington Police Station.	covid
