BACKFLOW 101-CROSS CONNECTION

Do you have.....

An Irrigation System? Fire Suppression System? Food Services?

Provide Medical Services? Hazardous Materials?

What is a Cross Connection....

A physical connection between the potable water supply and any material that renders the supply non-potable. The cross connection is created by backpressure or backsiphonage. **Backpressure** is the reversal of normal flow due to downstream pressure being greater than supply pressure. **Backsiphonage** is the reverse flow of water due to negative pressure. This can occur when there is a sudden drop in water pressure in the water main.

What can cause a Cross Connection....

- -Putting a hose down a drain to flush out debris
- Connecting your garden hose to a plant fertilizer applicator
- Filling up your hot tub with a garden hose

How do You prevent a Cross Connection....

A Backflow Preventer! This is a testable device which uses spring loaded check valves to prevent polluted or contaminated water from flowing back into the water supply.

Backflow testing requirements....

- Mandated by the state of Colorado...Regulation 11 Section 11.39 of the Colorado Primary Drinking Water Regulations
- Must have appropriate backflow installed per application
- Must pass annual inspection by a licensed certified tester
