Sometimes storms can be powerful reminders. I was driving back from a hospital visit my first day in office July 10th, when I ran into a torrential rain storm. Almost 2 inches of rain burst out of the sky in about an hour. I spent a half-hour pulled over in the parking lot of a local restaurant just praying that God would get me home to Emily and our parsonage. What was interesting for me was that despite the parsonage having all of our personal belongings for over a week, it had yet to feel like a home.

When we move, those first couple weeks can often feel like we are strangers in our own homes. It took a challenging storm to make my home feel like a safe refuge. Challenges in our spiritual lives can often have a similar effect. What spiritual storms in your life have you faced that made you aware that something or someone was closer that you thought? Paul said in Romans 5, "but we[d] also boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." God will lead us through these storms!

I want to thank everyone for a wonderful installation service. Our youth and adult choirs performed wonderful pieces, many members of our Moravian and local community came to celebrate with us, and our women hosted a fabulous brunch. I am learning that homemade sugar cake goes quickly!

The call process itself from a pastor's perspective can feel like you are making a very individualized decision to do ministry in a community. However, I am learning that even with a short amount of time in this community, how many helping hands I am surrounded by. We is always stronger than I. I am grateful to God for the many wonderful helpers God has blessed this community with!
