News from Eastern District / Northern Province

- The Provincial Elders Conference has decided to postpone Provincial Synod scheduled for the summer of 2021 and will plan to have Synod in 2022.
- Br. Eric Renner, currently serving as pastor of Shepherd of the Prairie Moravian Church in Fargo, North Dakota, has accepted a call to serve part-time as pastor of the Canaan Moravian Church in Davenport, North Dakota. He will remain under call to Shepherd of the Prairie but will be concluding his call at Hawley United Methodist.
- Br. Ian Edwards, who has been serving under appointment to the Eastern District, has accepted a sixmonth full-time appointment of the Provincial Elders' Conference to a newly created position tentatively called "Remote Pastoral Leader." He began this new appointment on April 15. Throughout this six-month experiment, Br. Edwards will provide worship leadership and limited pastoral care to three congregations across the province that are currently without a settled pastor.
- Sr. Sylvie Hauser has been hired as a Communications Consultant for the Northern Province to help the province tell the story of how we equip people and congregations to be agents of God's transforming love in the world. Sylvie will serve the province for 10 hours/week and will develop social media and other communications to reach more people with more information.


