There will be an opportunity to serve for everyone

The day of service is a reminder that mission does not need to take place in a foreign county or hundreds of miles away. Matthew 28:19-20, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Jesus reminds us that there are plenty of mission opportunities in our own backyard.
