CEC Meeting Summary: Held on Monday, July 12th on the parsonage lawn. We recapped VBS: Earth, Wind, and Fire. THANK YOU to everyone who helped and attended. We had a wonderful four days filled with finding God in nature. Over \$100 was donated towards our mission of helping to provide flowers for Schoenbrunn Village. We discussed upcoming Youth Events, Rally Day and Sunday School. We are preparing for a return to in-person Sunday School in October!
