Let us be grateful to the many dedicated servants we have been blessed with.

I neglected to share an important announcement at church council. The joint board made some changes to our building use policy that we feel will ease the process of securing hall rentals in the future. First of all, we have created separate forms for weddings and fellowship hall rentals. We are asking members pay a \$50 fee for hall rentals and non-members pay a \$100 fee. That does not mean a non-member is guaranteed to use the hall space, but we wanted members to be able to rent the hall at 1/2 price of other parties.

We also adjusted our fees for weddings of non-members. Non-members will be asked to pay a flat \$500/ fee for building use, the pastor, organist, media technicians, and wedding coordination. Members who are getting married will still have the building for free for weddings and would be asked to pay a stipend to those involved in the worship service.

If you have any questions please ask me or one of the other members of the joint board. It is important that we are good stewards to the wonderful building God has blessed us with.

Spiritual Companioning Small Group— Wednesday February 19th 7-8


