Greetings Schoenbrunn Family,

I am so grateful that this month we were able to successfully host our Church Council on Zoom. Thank you to all of you who were able to join us with this new format. For those of you that were not able to join us, I want to give a short recap of events.

God has been good to our congregation. There was so much gratitude shared and it seems our church family continues to step up in big ways throughout this pandemic. We are grateful that even with transitions to online worship we have never missed a Sunday. We are grateful that stewardship within the church remains strong. We paid off our last year of assessment paybacks and finished the year in the black. We remain grateful that ministries like Food on the Fly not only kept going but thrived in 2020.

The trustees shared with the congregation that a furnace fund has been started. Many of our furnaces are approaching 30 years of use, which is long past their expected life-expectancy. We are looking at new furnaces and potentially fellowship hall air conditioning (depending on cost) in the \$30,000 range. It is our goal to raise money with a 1-1-1 ratio. With every \$1 we raise being matched by \$1 of grants and \$1 of Denzer Trust money. We already have over \$1,600 in the fund and ask families to prayerfully consider tithing a part of their stimulus checks for the fund if they can.

We got some valuable feedback from the congregation about when most people would like to return to in-person worship. The majority of the people felt cases and hospitalizations had not dropped enough for a return. **The joint board decided at their re-organizational meeting to suspend in-person worship and activities through February**.

2020 was such a difficult year, but God did so much for our church and our families. May we continue to pay attention to the many blessings that have been bestowed upon us. Blessings, Pastor Ben
