Did you know that anxiety disorders are the most common mental illness diagnosed in the United States, affecting 40 million adults, according to the ADAA*? Even if we have never been diagnosed with anxiety, all of us have experienced anxiety in one form or another. Whether we are sitting in a doctor's office waiting for test results or we do not want to get out of bed in the morning because our list of things to do seems to be growing by the minute, we have all been impacted by anxiety at one point or another.

That is why for our Lenten series this year we will be focusing on best-selling author Max Lucado's DVD/book series *Anxious for Nothing*. We will examine how anxiety impacts our emotions, our actions, and our thoughts. We will look at Scripture and see that even Jesus dealt with an anxious age. Philippians 4:6-7 said, "Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

I think this study will be beneficial for all ages. Our Lenten soup and study will begin Wednesday March 4th and will be every Wednesday through April 11th. We will eat from 6:00 to 6:30 and study from 6:30-7:30. On Wednesday March 11th, we won't have soup but will have Food on the Fly meals available for all who sign up (with a suggested donation of \$8, or bring supper to join us!).

Come join us brothers and sisters! Lent is a time to reflect, pray, and ultimately journey closer to God. For we remember that the cross is not a place that shames, but it is a place that unites all sinners. For all our welcome beneath the cross of Jesus. Amen.


Help us Raise the Roof Fund!
