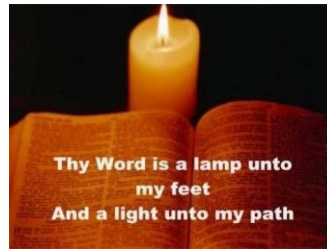
Help us Raise the Roof Fund!
