



Be careful not to number your 1st choice with a lower case "|", as this can potentially (fraudulently) be changed to a 4 or a 7 (multiple Candidates). Instead of "|", use 1 (in coloured pen). For numbering a square with a 7 put a small horizontal line across the 7 as 7. If you make a mistake on your ballot paper, <u>DO NOT</u> put a line through it & write the correct information beside it. In the event of an electoral dispute, all ballot papers are preserved for an investigation & crossed out ballot papers will be examined for tampering. So, if you make a mistake, do not worry because if any ballot paper has been spoiled inadvertently, you are legally entitled to have <u>a fresh ballot paper</u>, under Section 75 of the Electoral Act 1985 (SA). So, make your vote count. Your Vote. Your Choice.

The 51 Candidates (including 9 MPs) have been rated on valuing family, freedom and/or life. This 'rating' guide is *not* a 'How-to-Vote' card; and *did not* involve discussions with SA political parties/ Independents. It's for personal use; for all discerning SA Voters (Electors).

When attending a polling location to vote, remember to bring your choice of candidates/ parties list with you and take a <u>coloured pen (not black)</u>. For a 'formal' ballot paper, you must number at least 1 box (<u>above the red line</u>) on the **WHITE** Ballot Paper (Legislative Council). It is advised to number at least 6 squares (<u>above the red line</u>), to ensure your vote is not wasted; as 11 Candidates are to be elected to the Legislative Council. 6 squares (groups) have been rated as 'pro-liberty' &/or family/ life, <u>ABOVE red line</u> i.e.:

A = P J = 1 PHON M = 2 LIB DEM A = 3 NAT B = 4 FF F = 5 Ind. Q = 6

SA Voters (Electors) can number squares, <u>below</u> the <u>red line</u> - starting with a "1". Consecutively number at least 12 squares (1 to 12). It is however, strongly advised to number far <u>more</u> than 12 squares. To ensure a 'formal' ballot paper, an elector <u>cannot</u> number squares which are BOTH above and below the <u>red line</u>. Electors <u>must choose</u> to vote <u>either above or below</u> the <u>red line</u> on the <u>WHITE</u> ballot paper.

Please be careful not to number your 1st choice with a lower case "|", as this can potentially (fraudulently) be changed to a 4 or a 7 (for multiple Candidates). Instead of "|", use (in coloured pen). For numbering a square with a "7", put a small horizontal line across the 7, like this **.

If you make a mistake on your ballot paper, <u>DO NOT</u> put a line through it and write the correct information beside it. As all SA completed ballot papers are preserved for a time, in the event of an electoral dispute, where an investigation follows, any crossed out ballot papers will be examined for tampering. So, if you make a mistake, do not worry. If any ballot paper has been spoiled inadvertently, you are legally "entitled" to have a "fresh" ballot paper, under Section 75 of the South Australia Electoral Act 1985.

Please decide on your *own* choice of candidates/ parties in <u>Legislative Council</u> (Upper House) on the WHITE ballot paper.

So, make your vote count. Your Vote. Your Choice.



The Author (Sharon Cousins) is an independent Researcher, Writer and Political Analyst, who has experience of Federal, State, Territory and Local Council Elections. Since 2003, has voluntarily assisted various political party Candidates and Independents either as a Campaign Worker or Coordinator with election documentation, research, marketing and writing or reviewing Candidate profile statements.

In 2011, ran as the only ungrouped female Independent Candidate amongst over 80 Candidates in a Local Council Election, whilst additionally voluntarily helping in the campaign for another Independent Candidate from a different local ward; who later became an elected Councillor.

In April 2019, through prayer and guidance, embarked on a Federal Election project that had never before been attempted in the history of Australian elections and was warned "This is deep water stuff". In a collaborative effort with a number of people and organisations involved in analysing political party policies, values and preferential voting, developed guidelines for a discretionary rating order of political parties, according to those that supported family-friendly values and 'life'.

These guidelines were named "Vote Wisely", which were initially produced for each of the 6 States and 2 Territories and released the night before the 2019 Federal Election (held on Saturday, 18th May 2019). Has since produced voting guidelines (resource documents) for NT, ACT and QLD Elections in 2020 and WA and TAS Elections in 2021. For SA Election 2022, helped develop a rating guide for discerning voters, based on parties/ candidates valuing family, freedom &/or life. 'YOUR VOTE. YOUR CHOICE.'

From late February to 12th March 2022, undertook research and analysis for production of an 'authorised' resource document (for personal use), called *"Vote Wisely"* for the **SA State Election 2022**. <u>Sourced</u>:

- 1. <u>SA Parliament website & Hansard</u> on who of the 47 Electorate Legislative Assembly Members and 22 Legislative Council Members, voted for/against abortion-up-to-birth and euthanasia.
- Electoral Commission South Australia website (ECSA) for voting instructions, electorate and ballot information, list of 47 Electorates (from ADELAIDE to WRIGHT), the 240 Candidates in Legislative Assembly (Lower House), 51 Candidates in Legislative Council (Upper House) and 14 political parties.
- 3. <u>ABC News SA Election 2022 website</u> for historical information on 2018 Election, electorates, parties, candidates, links to candidate/ political party websites and profile information (where available) etc.
- 4. <u>Political Parties and Independent Candidates websites/ social media pages</u> for any policies, values and profiles of candidates/ state members.
- 5. <u>Organisations & News websites</u> for information on how SA MP's voted on abortion-up-to-birth and Euthanasia; candidate background details (civic ability/experience, community work, values/ policies).

The resource document known as "Vote Wisely" (developed since Federal Election 2019), is coincidentally the same name used separately by the organisation, <u>FamilyVoice</u>, for their election website information, entitled "Be Informed. Know the Key Issues. VOTE WISELY".
