

Tips on How to Find Information on Candidates/Parties for Voters

- 1. After locating your QLD electorate https://results.ecq.qld.gov.au/state_district_maps/ find the ballot paper order and names of the Candidates/Parties in your electorate.
- 2. Choose which are your preferred Candidates/Parties and go to the political party or candidate website and/or Facebook page to seek further profile details e.g. community work, civic ability, skills and values.
- 3. After finding the Candidate's political party or own website, read the policies (if available). Alternatively search the Candidate's name and the Electorate on Facebook.
- 4. Go to ABC News Elections QLD 2024 Guides which shows electorate information, margin %, past elections results, Candidates profiles, photos and website links (where published). https://www.abc.net.au/news/elections/qld/2024/guides
- 5. Seek extra websites (as listed on page 6 of this Vote Wisely resource document) to help source information e.g. MP Voting records and responses by political parties and candidates to questionnaires.
- 6. Additional information type the candidate's name into a browser search engine using quotation marks at beginning (before first name) and at end of surname e.g. "Joe Bloggs". For some Candidates, this method of internet searching does not work; hence the need to search party/candidate websites, Facebook and ABC News Elections QLD 2024 Guides.
- 7. If in any doubt as to which is your preferred candidate, search for their contact details (if available) to ask them any questions. A trustworthy recommendation about a Candidate may also be useful.
- 8. Make a decision as to your choice of Candidates in your preferred order for the electorate ballot paper.

Make your vote count - Vote wisely.
