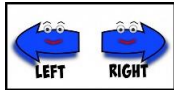

*An overview of Life and Family Values of selected parties in the 2021 WA election*

## Know the Liberal Party

- ★ No policy to change abortion law
- ★ No policy to oppose censorship zones around abortion clinics
- ★ Liberal MPs have demanded investigation into babies born alive and left to die, forcing the Coroner to investigate 27 deaths from 1999-2018

- ★ No party policy to support euthanasia and several MLCs opposed the bill, and several supported it.
- ★ Committed to funding palliative care to national benchmarks

- ★ No policy to criminalise evidence-based therapy for people who are confused about their sexuality or gender

- ★ No policy to fund a 'Safe Schools' whole-of-school gender ideology

- ★ No policy to stop changes to the freedom of faith-based schools to hire or exclude staff who oppose the school's faith values

- ★ Conscience vote on life issues, such as human reproductive technology

## Know the Labor Party

- ★ Supports abortion for any reason
- ★ Labor censorship zone bill would **ban distressed women from hearing about pregnancy support** within 150m of abortion clinic
- ★ No policy to end the macabre practise of leaving babies to die after a 'failed abortion'

- ★ Labor bill **legalised** doctor- or self-administered **deadly poison** (as of late 2021)
- ★ Palliative care funding falls short of the national benchmark of two full-time-equivalent specialists per 100,000 people

- ★ Is formally considering a Victorian-style bill that criminalises patient-led, evidence-based therapy, counselling or prayer for those who want help with unwanted sexual attraction or gender dysphoria
- ★ Has asked the WA Law Reform Commission to propose expansion of pro-LGBT laws

- ★ Has previously funded and promoted 'Respectful Relationships' **whole-of-school gender ideology** in state schools, and **kept list of participating schools secret from the public**

- ★ Supports removing freedom of faith-based schools to employ and exclude staff and teachers that uphold the parent's wishes for their school's values

- ★ Labor-supported bill gave homosexual couples and single men right to surrogacy and erased mother's biological connection to her child

## Know the Australian Christians Party

- ★ Opposes legalised killing of preborn children
- ★ Supports pro-child, pro-woman pregnancy support information offered near abortion locations
- ★ Supports open parliamentary inquiry into babies left to die in WA, and enhancing protections for children who survive an abortion

- ★ Opposes legalising deadly poisons for vulnerable lives at end-of-life phase
- ★ Supports funding palliative care to exceed national benchmarks
- ★ Supports the expansion of regional palliative care facilities

- ★ Supports counsellors, therapists, pastors, chaplains and health workers offering professional sexuality and gender guidance
- ★ Will vote against any bill that seeks to criminalise evidence-based therapy
- ★ Supports parental rights to seek counselling for confused children

- ★ Supports a parental rights bill that requires schools have full pre-disclosure of programs or modules that relate in any way to early years development, wellbeing, sexuality and gender

- ★ Supports freedom of association and freedom of conscience of faith-based schools to hire and exclude staff according to its values

- ★ Opposes commercial surrogacy, because such a practice commodifies human life

# Australian Christian Values Checklist

13 March 2021  
WA State Election

This summary of the positions of major parties on issues of concern to Christians is provided as a service to the Christian community. In the 2016 Census 52% of Australians identified themselves as Christian. On many welfare and social justice issues the party policies are very similar. Our aim is to deal with the moral and ethical issues that are rarely, if ever, discussed publicly in an election campaign but which are important issues that affect the very foundation of our society. The team that compiles the checklist make independent assessments and are not members of any political party. This checklist has been compiled after an exhaustive search of party websites, voting history, statements, including in some cases the voting record of their Federal counterparts. Positions are often difficult to summarise in a format of this kind, and parties have not always made definitive statements. Therefore a "?" indicates in some instances a conscience vote, or a less than conclusive opinion on the party's position on some of the issues. Tick equals YES ✓ X equals NO ✗

### VOTING INSTRUCTIONS - COLOURED BALLOT PAPER (6 REGIONS - LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL)

When completing the coloured Ballot Paper in your Region, there are 2 options for voting:

- a) Put a 1 in one box only, for your preferred choice above the line (a "ticket vote") OR
- b) For your "**Candidate preference vote**", you need to number *all* boxes below the line, starting with a 1 and then continue to number 2, 3, 4...., etc., until *all* other boxes are numbered, in the order of your choice. This will take time and concentration as the 6 Regions (coloured Ballot Papers) have between 47 to 64 Candidate names to complete below the line. You will need to carefully find your chosen Parties/ Candidates below the line. If you make a mistake, ask for another coloured Ballot Paper.

*Please do not* complete both sections of the coloured Ballot Paper. It is your decision, as to which of the 2 options above you would prefer to use for the coloured Ballot Paper, Legislative Council (Upper House).

WA Parliament Hansard recorded on 24.9.2019 (page 7297), 45 “Ayes” from certain Members of the Legislative Assembly (Lower House), who voted FOR euthanasia (Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill 2019).
