# Australian Christian Values Checklist 13 March 2021 WA State Election

This summary of the positions of major parties on issues of concern to Christians is provided as a service to the Christian community, In the 2016 Census \$2% of Australians identified themselves as Christian. On many welfare and social justice issues the party policies are very similar. Our aim is to deal with the moral and ethical issues that are rarely, if ever, discussed publically in an election campaign but which are important issues that are floct the very foundation of our society. The team that compiles the checklist make independent assessments and are not members of any political party. This checklist has been compiled after an exhaustive search of party websites, voting history, statements, including in some cases the voting record of their Federal counterparts. Positions are often difficult to summarise in a format of this kind, and parties have not always made deficitive attemperator. Therefore, 2½ Indicates in some instances a conscience as a con

- b) For your "Candidate preference vote", you need to number all boxes <u>below the line</u>, starting with a 1 and then continue to number 2, 3, 4...., etc., until all other boxes are numbered, in the order of your choice. This will take time and concentration as the 6 Regions (coloured Ballot Papers) have between 47 to 64 Candidate names to complete <u>below the line</u>. You will need to carefully find your chosen Parties/ Candidates <u>below the line</u>. If you make a mistake, ask for another coloured Ballot Paper.

*Please do not* complete both sections of the coloured Ballot Paper. It is your decision, as to which of the 2 options above you would prefer to use for the coloured Ballot Paper, Legislative Council (Upper House).




