 Click ‘**Show all candidates**’, ‘**NT**’ and ‘**Senate candidates**’ to view the list of **17 Senate Candidates (Groups A to H and an Ungrouped Candidate)**.

This ‘*personal*’ rating guide is based on freedom-friendly minor parties/ candidates (pro-life &/or pro-liberty), candidate’s backgrounds, skills, civic experience/ ability, social values, policies, candidate forums, analysis of ‘How-to-Vote’ preferences and candidate profiles/answers on **Reignite Democracy Australia ‘Federal Candidate Survey - 2022’**.

For Voters (Electors) who *prefer* to number squares for *individual* Senate candidates, **below the line** – you must consecutively number at least 12 boxes (1 to 12). It is however, strongly advised to number *more* than 12 boxes (*below the line*). Alternatively, an Elector has the option to number **above the line**; but they must number 6 squares on the **WHITE** Ballot Paper (Senate), starting with “1” for their first choice.

If a Voter chooses to **number ALL boxes** (squares), **either above or below the line**, then this ensures their vote is not wasted (termed ‘exhausted’). Also, if any boxes are left blank, there is a risk of electoral fraud e.g., a dishonest counter may number an empty box, rendering the ballot paper informal (unlikely but possible). Electors **must choose** to vote **either** above or below the line, on the Senate white ballot paper.

Please note, when voting via a postal application or attending a polling location, preferably don’t use a pencil (if possible). Use your **own pen**.

**TIPS:** For your first choice, on your white ballot paper, try to avoid writing your number “1” using a lower case “l”; as this could potentially (fraudulently) be changed to a 4 or a 7. Instead of “l”, use **1** (in pen). For numbering a square with a “7”, put a small horizontal line across 7, like this . If you make a mistake on your ballot paper, **DO NOT** put a line through it and then try to correct it. Just ask for a fresh ballot paper. Choose your *own* candidates (Groups/ Parties/ Independents) for the **Senate** *either* above or below the line, on the **WHITE** ballot paper, in *your* preference order.

**Recommendations:**

1. Review the *below the line* order (**1 to 17** Senate Candidates). If needed, use the column shown as ‘**Own Pref #**’ and re-number to suit your *own* preference order.
2. For a ‘rated’ list of **NT Senate Groups/ Parties (above the line)**, visit ‘**Senate Guides**’ on <https://votewisely.godaddysites.com/>
3. Once satisfied with **either** your list of **1 to 17 (below the line)**, or **1 to 8 NT Groups A - H (above the line)**, keep a copy for voting.
4. When completing your ballot paper, take your time and **carefully** and **accurately** number the boxes, in your *own* preference order.
