# Make your <mark>vote count</mark>

Click 'Show all candidates', 'NT' and 'Senate candidates' to view the list of <u>17 Senate Candidates (Groups A to H and an Ungrouped Candidate)</u>. This '<u>personal</u>' rating guide is based on freedom-friendly minor parties/ candidates (pro-life &/or pro-liberty), candidate's backgrounds, skills, civic experience/ ability, social values, policies, candidate forums, analysis of 'How-to-Vote' preferences and candidate profiles/answers on **Reignite Democracy Australia** 'Federal Candidate Survey - 2022'. https://www.reignitedemocracyaustralia.com.au/myvc/

For Voters (Electors) who *prefer* to number squares for *individual* Senate candidates, <u>below the line</u> – you must consecutively number at least 12 boxes (1 to 12). It is however, strongly advised to number *more* than 12 boxes (*below the line*). Alternatively, an Elector has the option to number <u>above the line</u>; but they must number 6 squares on the **WHITE** Ballot Paper (Senate), starting with "1" for their first choice.

If a Voter chooses to **number ALL boxes** (squares), **either above or below the line**, then this ensures their vote is not wasted (termed 'exhausted'). Also, if any boxes are left blank, there is a risk of electoral fraud e.g., a dishonest counter may number an empty box, rendering the ballot paper informal (unlikely but possible). Electors **must choose** to vote <u>either</u> above or below the line, on the Senate white ballot paper.

Please note, when voting via a postal application or attending a polling location, preferably don't use a pencil (if possible). Use your *own pen*.

<u>**TIPS**</u>: For your first choice, on your white ballot paper, try to avoid writing your number "1" using a lower case "|"; as this could potentially (fraudulently) be changed to a 4 or a 7. Instead of "|", use  $\boxed{1}$  (in pen). For numbering a square with a "7", put a small horizontal line across 7,

like this **1**. If you make a mistake on your ballot paper, **DO NOT** put a line through it and then try to correct it. Just ask for a fresh ballot paper. Choose your *own* candidates (Groups/ Parties/ Independents) for the **Senate** *either* above or below the line, on the **WHITE** ballot paper, in *your* preference order.

#### **Recommendations**:

- Review the <u>below the line</u> order (1 to 17 Senate Candidates). If needed, use the column shown as 'Own Pref #' and re-number to suit your own preference order.
- 2. For a 'rated' list of **NT Senate Groups/ Parties** (above the line), visit <u>'Senate Guides'</u> on <u>https://votewisely.godaddysites.com/</u>
- Once satisfied with *either* your list of 1 to 17 (*below the line*), or 1 to 8 NT Groups A - H (*above the line*), keep a copy for voting.
- 4. When completing your ballot paper, take your time and <u>carefully</u> and <u>accurately</u> number the boxes, in your *own* preference order.
