This <u>'personal'</u> rating guide is based on freedom-friendly minor parties/

candidates (pro-life &/or pro-liberty), candidate's backgrounds, skills, civic experience/ ability, social values, policies, candidate forums, analysis of 'How-to-Vote' preferences and candidate profiles/answers on **Reignite Democracy Australia** *'Federal Candidate Survey - 2022'*. https://www.reignitedemocracyaustralia.com.au/myvc/

For Voters (Electors) who *prefer* to number squares for *individual* Senate candidates, <u>below the line</u> – you must consecutively number at least 12 boxes (1 to 12). It is however, strongly advised to number *more* than 12 boxes (*below the line*). Alternatively, an Elector has the option to number <u>above the line</u>; but they must number 6 squares on the **WHITE** Ballot Paper (Senate), starting with "1" for their first choice.

If a Voter chooses to **number ALL boxes** (squares), **either above or below the line**, then this ensures their vote is not wasted (termed 'exhausted'). Also, if any boxes are left blank, there is a risk of electoral fraud e.g., a dishonest counter may number an empty box, rendering the ballot paper informal (unlikely but possible). Electors **must choose** to vote <u>either</u> above or below the line, on the Senate white ballot paper.

Please note, when voting via a postal application or attending a polling location, preferably don't use a pencil (if possible). Use your *own pen*.

TIPS: For your first choice, on your white ballot paper, try to avoid writing your number "1" using a lower case "**|**"; as this could potentially (fraudulently) be changed to a 4 or a 7. Instead of "**|**", use **1** (in pen). For numbering a square with a "7", put a small horizontal line across 7,

like this \mathcal{T} . If you make a mistake on your ballot paper, <u>DO NOT</u> put a line through it and then try to correct it. Just ask for a fresh ballot paper. Choose your *own* candidates (Groups/ Parties/ Independents) for the **Senate** *either* above or below the line, on the **WHITE** ballot paper, in *your* preference order.

Recommendations:

- Review the <u>below the line</u> order (1 to 39 Senate Candidates). If needed, use the column shown as 'Own Pref #' and re-number to suit your own preference order.
- For list of TAS Senate Groups/ Parties (above the line), visit <u>'Senate Rating Guides'</u> on <u>https://votewisely.godaddysites.com/</u>
 Once esticiate with aither your list of 1 to 20 (below the line) or
- Once satisfied with *either* your list of 1 to 39 (*below the line*), or 1 to 14 TAS Groups A - N (*above the line*), keep a copy for voting.
- 4. When completing your ballot paper, take your time and <u>carefully</u> and <u>accurately</u> number the boxes, in your *own* preference order.
