RioGAFA Directors

a. Michele Platis

- i. Math Grant- for instructional materials
- ii. High Impact grant- for student tutors to accelerate learning in math and reading
- iii. ELA- getting new curriculum up and running
- iv. Testing Scores Released
 - 1. Language Arts went up by 58%, outperforming the State. Rio GAFA was highlighted. Other demographics also performed exceptionally well.
 - 2. Math- 17% proficiency, 4% growth. 8th grade increased 17%. All increases out performed last year.
 - 3. Science- 3% over 2025

b. Jordan Franco

- i. Enrollment- 240 students currently. Expecting to get to 250,
 - 1. Doing movie, radio and social media ads. Will do an interview on KOB, upcoming, to prepare for getting more students enrolled, especially with upcoming building. May hire more support staff at 40th day, depending on enrollment.
- ii. Attendance- 89%. Doing more activities in Oct to promote higher attendance.
- iii. Facility update- Received approval from DFT. Groundbreaking expected in October!
 - 1. Updated budget- slightly over budget as it is right now. To get tighter numbers, expected to have lower expenses.
 - 2. \$1M in contingency funds- hard and soft costs
 - 3. Shared building plans and site plan
- iv. Corinne- which ads are most successful? Most successful are Spanish radio ads. Also from Social Media, with most funding in this area.
