Gruet Brut Rosé (New Mexic

Veuve Clicquot Brut (Champagne, France)

Grapes: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier

A classic Champagne with notes of crisp apple, citrus, and a touch of toasty bread. Smooth bubbles and a bright finish make it both elegant and easy to enjoy for any celebration..

Piper-Heidsieck Brut (Champagne, France)

Grapes: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier

Lively and dynamic with aromas of pear, toasted nuts, and citrus peel. The palate balances freshness with a creamy mid-palate and an elegant, chalky finish.

Toressella Prosecco (Veneto, Italy)

Grape: Glera

Fresh and vibrant with notes of green apple, and pear. Crisp, citrus-driven finish ideal as an aperitif.

Veuve Clicquot Rosé (Champagne, France)

Grapes: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier

Bright and refined, blending red berry notes with a subtle toasty richness.

Gruet Brut Rosé (New Mexico, USA)

Grapes: Predominantly Pinot Noir

A dry, zesty domestic sparkling with vibrant red fruit notes, crisp structure, and delicate bubbles that rival French versions.

White Wines

Terra Alpina Pinot Grigio

Grape: Pinot Grigio

From the Dolomites' cool alpine slopes. Lemon, pear, and flint notes with a dry, elegant finish.

Vint Chardonnay (California, USA)

Grape: Chardonnay

A modern, balanced expression of California fruit—ripe pear and baked apple framed by subtle oak and vanilla. Medium-bodied with refreshing acidity.

Toscolà Vernaccia (San Gimignano, Italy)

Grape: Vernaccia

One of Italy's oldest white varieties. Crisp and mineral-driven with flavors of citrus, almond, and white peach. Clean, slightly saline finish—perfect with shellfish or grilled vegetables.

Centorri Moscato (Lombardy, Italy)

Grape: Moscato Bianco

Lightly sparkling, with aromas of ripe peach, tangerine, and honeysuckle. Sweet yet refreshing, thanks to balancing acidity.

Selbach Riesling (Mosel, Germany)

Grape: Riesling

A lively, slightly sweet white wine with bright flavors of lime and green apple. Light, crisp, and perfectly balanced, it's a great match for spicy food or anything with bold flavors.

Lagaria Pinot Grigio (Trentino, Italy)

Grape: Pinot Grigio

Mountain freshness defines this wine—lime zest, green apple, and crushed stone. Crisp, clean, and recommended if you had, or plan on having, seafood or light pasta for dinner.

Rosé

The Pinot Project Rosé (Veneto, Italy)

Grape: Pinot Noir

Dry and aromatic with bright strawberry, watermelon, and rose petal notes.

Refreshing, crisp and clean finish—versatile and elegant.

Côte de Roses Rosé (Languedoc, France)

Grapes: Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah

A visually stunning bottle and wine alike—delicate floral aromas, with wild strawberry, and peach. Crisp, elegant, and balanced in true Mediterranean style.

Studio by Miraval Rosé (Provence, France)

Grapes: Cinsault, Grenache, Rolle, Tibouren

A coastal Provençal rosé—pale salmon hue with aromas of grapefruit, and white peach. Dry, silky, and impeccably refined.

Red Wines

Beaujolais Depeuble (Beaujolais, France)

Grape: Gamay

Juicy and vibrant with notes of cherry, cranberry, and violet. Light-bodied, and unoaked.

Crossbarn Pinot Noir (Sonoma Coast, California, USA)

Grape: Pinot Noir

Elegant and flavorful, with red cherry, pomegranate, and a hint of earthiness.

Smooth texture, bright acidity, and a clean, refined finish show its cool-climate style.

Adelsheim Pinot Noir (Willamette Valley, Oregon, USA)

Grape: Pinot Noir

Elegant and aromatic, with layers of red currant, raspberry, and spice. Fine tannins and bright acidity showcase Oregon's hallmark balance between fruit and earth.

Red Wines

Ramsay Merlot (North Coast, California, USA)

Grape: Merlot

Velvety and ripe, showing plum, dark cherry, and cocoa. Medium-to-full-bodied with supple tannins and a long, rounded finish—classic California approachability.

Altos Las Hormigas Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina)

Grape: Malbec

Smooth and balanced, with flavors of black plum and a hint of floral and earthy notes. Light on oak, keeping it fresh and clean, showing the bright character of Mendoza's mountain vineyards.

Trione Zinfandel (Sonoma County, California, USA)

Grape: Zinfandel

Concentrated and spicy, with blackberry jam, black pepper, and hints of vanilla. Full-bodied yet balanced by lively acidity and structured tannins.

Castle Rock Cabernet Sauvignon (California, USA)

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon

A classic, fruit-forward California Cabernet with blackberry, cassis, and gentle oak spice. Soft tannins make it an easy-drinking red.

Fog and Light Cabernet Sauvignon (California, USA)

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon

Rich and plush with ripe blackcurrant, mocha, and cedar notes. Smooth texture and balanced acidity—modern yet elegant.

Hess Cabernet Sauvignon (North Coast, California, USA)

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon

Rich and full-bodied, with dark fruit, coffee, and earthy notes. Smooth tannins and a long, flavorful finish show off its high-mountain origins..

Barolo Albe (Piedmont, Italy)

Grape: Nebbiolo

High-elevation Nebbiolo yields a refined, aromatic Barolo with silky tannins and vibrant acidity. The wine's rose petal and red fruit character pairs beautifully with fresh game and decadent pasta.
