FunShine Express follows a four-year rotation of themes and activities.

Themes for Buttercups and Fireflies are coordinated. Schedule is subject to slight changes.

September

Shape: Circle Color: Red Opposites: In/Out

Wonderful Me: What makes each person special? Come find out in this unique theme that celebrates the personality and abilities of each child. Playful activities help children build strong relationships with each other and their caregivers.

Where We Live: Everyone has a home, but not all homes are the same. In this theme, children will learn about many kinds of homes and the people and animals who live in them. Children will make connections between their homes and their home away from home—your setting!

October

Shape: Triangle
Color: Orange
Opposites: In/Out

Curious Critters: Curious critters are everywhere! Help children learn more about the everyday animals that surround them. Discover squirrels, raccoons, mice, and more in this theme as you move like animals, explore textures and sounds, and settle into autumn.

Fairy Tale Friends: Let imaginations run wild as you introduce the children to classic tales and nursery rhymes! Foster vocabulary development and a love for reading as you build castles and pretend play together.

November

Shape: Star Color: Brown Opposites: On/Off

Cooling Down: As fall changes to winter, the children will find seasonal changes fascinating. Snuggle up as the weather cools down and explore ways that animals and humans prepare for winter and how trees and plants change.

Barnyard Bash: Life on the farm is filled with adventure! In this theme, children will investigate all aspects of farm life, including animals, barns, harvesting crops, farming jobs, and equipment.

December

Shape: Star Color: Green Opposites: On/Off

Five Super Senses: The winter and holiday seasons call upon our senses in special ways. Whether it's the lights of decorations, the scent of fresh-baked cookies, or the warmth of a soft scarf, there's so much to see, smell, feel, hear, and taste this time of year. This theme explores it all and offers helpful child development tips about the senses!

Merry Memories: Capture this special time of year by making merry memories! Children will dance, sing, and play games to celebrate holidays, the new year, and your time together.

January

Shape: Heart
Color: White
Opposites: Clean/Dirty

Snow Friends: Winter is a time to bundle up and get outdoors to play in the fluffy, white snow! Children will explore snowflakes, snowmen, and ice this month. They will also develop an awareness of many animals that live in snowy places.

Scribbles and Splats: Bring out your easels and paint palettes, this theme invites children to discover their inner artist! Painting, coloring, and shaping playdough are just a few of the art techniques explored. Children will also learn about art tools, helping to clean up, and the beginning of self-expression.

February

Shape: Heart
Color: Pink
Opposites: Clean/Dirty

Children will share the pride they take in toys from home with a special show-and-tell day. Turn-taking will also be explored.

Hopping & Hatching: Learn about bunnies and chicks and other baby animals in this spring theme. Children will practice using gentle hands, notice early signs of spring, and explore all types of sounds and movements.

April

Opposites: Open/Closed

Puddle Play: There are many changes in nature during spring. The pitter-patter of April showers may be followed by thunderstorms, mud puddles, sunshine, and rainbows. Explore all the changes spring has to offer during this theme.

Sail Away: Children will love pretending to sail across blue waters, floating toy boats in water, moving to sailing songs, and much more in this aquatic transportation theme!

Flower Shop: April showers bring May flowers! Children will have fun learning about all kinds of flowers and ways to care for them. Create a pretend flower shop and explore simple gardening. Children will also learn about pollination during this theme.

Animals All Around: Big and small, short and tall, scaly and furry—children will love stories, rhymes, and more featuring all kinds of animals. They can explore with their whole bodies as they imitate animal sounds and movements. Domestic and wild animals are covered.
