Important Information

- EDRC will follow all Covid-19 Government guidelines at time of event.
- Anyone showing Covid-19 symptoms should not attend.
- EDRC Back numbers will be allocated on day. Pre entries must check in on day and receive EDRC number. Bridle number holders should be positioned to ensure visibility.
- All horses must have been vaccinated for Equine Influenza within the last 12 months.
- Please enter classes with the intention of having fun and enjoying the day, in the way we intend to run this event.

Rules of Entry

When entering a pony/horse it is a condition of entry that these rules are abided by.

1. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they are present in the ring at the start of the class.
2. Refunds of class will not be given if exhibitors miss their class
3. The Judges decision is final
4. All classes Horses / Ponies will be judged together
5. EDRC reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide any class should entries warrant.
6. All riders must be of correct age and weight suited to their mount
7. All exhibitors must be of competent ability and in control at all times
8. Handlers and grooms must be appropriately dressed to type including footwear.
9. Correct secured hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted and to current BSI Standard
10. All handlers under the age of 14 must wear correct hat to current BSI standard whilst in ring.
11. Show canes and whips must be no more than 30 inches long
12. All pony's 14.2h and under
13. All horse's 14.3h and over
14. Hack's 14.2h -16h and of type build
15. No horses / ponies under the age of 4 to be ridden on the show field
16. No Ridden Stallions
17. Gallop is not permitted on the show field other than in rings
18. Ponies / horses must leave the ring in walk
19. All horses ponies must have a valid passport which should be presented at entry box for inspection
20. All persons entering the showground must have personal third party insurance.
21. Objections – to be made in writing to the secretary with a deposit of £15.00 cash, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. All objections must be made within 30 minutes of the class taking place.
22. EDRC accept no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to any person or to their property whilst on site. All entries are subject to these conditions
23. EDRC reserve the right to expel from the class or show field any animal not considered to be under control, especially where a danger to the public could be created.
24. No litter to be left on show field. **CLEANING OUT HORSE BOX & TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**
25. Dogs must be on a lead and supervised at all times
26. All horses/ ponies tied to lorry or trailer **MUST** be supervised at all times. Any horse/pony left unattended should be safely secured in lorry/trailer.

In Hand

All classes may be split Horses/Ponies if entries justify

Ring 1 9.30 am start Judge: tbc

- Class 1** **Best Turned Out in hand** *Open to all types, Judged on the turnout of the horse/pony and handler*
- Class 2** **Mountain and Moorland small/large breeds pure and part bred** *Shown in their natural state.
Small: Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A, Welsh B. Large: Highlands, Dales, Fells, Connemara, Welsh C,D, New Forest
Entries are excluded from class 3
This class will be split small/large breeds according to entries*
- Class 3** **Open Horse Pony** *Open to all horses / ponies that are shown according to type
E.g. Hunter, Hack, Cob, Ridden, Hunter pony, Show Pony, Riding pony
Traditional, Hogged or Plated
(Excluding entries from class 2)*
- Class 4** **Coloured Horse Pony** *Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Spotted, Dun, Roan, Palomino etc.
Traditional, Hogged or Plaited,
Judged on the colouration and markings*
- Class 5** **ROR** *Open to all racehorses who have retired from racing*
- Class 6** **Veteran over 16 years** *Open to Horses, Ponies of any type that are aged 16 years and over
Special Rosette for the oldest still showing
Age to be shown on passport*
- Class 7** **Open Best Condition** *Open to any age or type. This class will be judged on the condition of the Horse, Pony*
- Class 8** **Handsome Gelding / Pretty Mare** *Open to Horses / Ponies Class will be split Geldings/Mare*

In Hand Champion *Those place 1st or 2nd in classes 1-8 will qualify for the In Hand Champion and Reserve Champion. This will take place in ring 1 after class 8*

Ridden

Ring 2 not before 11.00 Judge: tbc

- Class 10** **Open Tack and Turned Out inc Lead Rein** *Judged on the turnout of the Horse / Pony and Rider / leader*
- Class 11** **Best Ridden Mountain and Moorland small / large breeds pure and part bred** *Shown in their natural state.
Small: Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A, Welsh B. Large: Highlands, Dales, Fells, Connemara, Welsh C,D, New Forest
Entries are excluded from class 14
This class will be split small/large breeds according to entries*
- Class 12** **First Ridden inc lead rein 12yrs and under for ponies not exceeding 14.2hh.**
*Judged on suitability and harmony of pony and rider
Where applicable lead rein to be attached to the noseband and not the bit. To be lead by an attendant aged 14yrs or older.
Walk, Trot only no canter
Riders age to be declared.
(Rider may not compete in any other class off the lead rein)*
- Class 13** **Novice Ridden** *Open to Horses / Ponies never to have been placed 1ST-3rd in a ridden showing class.
Snaffle bridle only. Walk Trot only no canter*
- Class 14** **Open Best Ridden** *For all types / breeds Horses Ponies that are shown according to type
E.g. Hunter, Hack, Cob, Ridden, Hunter pony, Show Pony, Riding Pony
Traditional, Hogged or Plaited
Gallop can be shown in individual show at the discretion of the rider but will not influence judge's decision
(Excluding entries in M&M , Lead Rein, First, Novice ridden)*
- Class 15** **Best Ridden Veteran over 16 years** *Open to Horse / Ponies of any type that are aged 16 years and over
Special Rosette for the oldest still ridden
Age to be shown on passport*
- Class 16** **ROR** *Open to all racehorses who have retired from racing*
- Class 17** **Best Ridden Riding Club Type** *Open to Horses / Ponies inc Lead Rein. Small obstacle course to be completed*

Ridden Championship *Those place 1st or 2nd in classes 10-17 will qualify for the Ridden Champion and Reserve Champion . This will take place in ring 2 after class 17*
