All helmets must be current Equestrian Australia standard.

- Course Walk times will be 7am Friday & Saturday morning

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

One member of the Four Phase Team must register the team name before the members of the team can enter.

9 March 2026 - Four Phase Team Name Registrations will open

16 March 2026 - Four Phase Registrations will open

23 March 2026 - Individual Three Phase Registrations will open



## ENTRIES CLOSE

Entries will close on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> April, or before if full.

Entries are capped and once full names will be taken on a wait list.

## 4 PHASE TEAM ENTRIES

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders from levels 2 to 8. The teams will participate in all 4 phases, including the cattle phase.

*Horse and rider combination must have previous cattle training or competition experience*
