*Ease of Handling (EOH) & Speed course and scheduled course walk times will be available minimum one week prior to competition.*

## ENTRIES CLOSE

Entries will close on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April, or before if full.

Entries are capped and once full names will be taken on a wait list.

## TEAM ENTRIES

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders.

- Riders must be an ANWE club member with a current ANWE Rider Levy number.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

One member of the Four Phase Team must register the team name before the members of the team can enter.

21 March 2025 - Four Phase Team Name Registrations will open

28 March 2025 - Four Phase Registrations will open

4 April 2025 - Individual Three Phase Registrations will open

## CONDITION OF ENTRY

All riders are required to volunteer at least 2 hours of their time over the duration of the event or provide a helper in their place.

## CATTLE TEAMS

Cattle Teams must be either;

- all Preparatory (Level 2, all divisions), or
- all Competitor (Level 3 and above, all divisions)

*Horse and rider combination must have previous cattle training or competition experience*

## AWARDS

(\*For each level and division)

### **Competitor Level**

Individual 3 Phase - Champion and Reserve Champion, places to 4<sup>th</sup> – Sash and prize\*

Fastest Cattle runs (all levels) - 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place - Ribbons

Cattle teams – 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place - Sashes

4 Phase Teams – 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place - Sashes

### **Training level**

Individual 3 Phase – 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place – Ribbons\*

Fastest Cattle runs (Preparatory) - 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place - Ribbons

Cattle teams - 1<sup>st</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> places (Preparatory) - Ribbons

## BRIDLE NUMBERS

Riders must display bridle or saddle cloth numbers, on both sides.

Numbers allocated on draw.
