

SBBC Long Distance Series and Races

Supplementary instructions 04/01/2026

To be read in conjunction with;

- **Latest SBBC Race procedure** (current version September 2025)
- **SBBC Virtual Sailing Marks – 2026**

- 1) The SBBC Long Distance Series consists of up to five races sailed around “Mercury Passage” keeping within the limitations of an AS level 5 race.
- 2) A minimum of three races will constitute a series.
- 3) The series score will be the best of three races. Races will use the low scoring system. There is only one division.
- 4) All races start and finish at the Eastcoaster line “E”
- 5) Marks of the courses. Any of the “outside” SBBC physical marks” ie. “E”, “W”, “R”, “Z”, “S” and “L” (Luther Point, not yet laid), “Lachlan Island” and any of the virtual marks “PR”, “PL”, “SM”, “D” and “NW”, location details listed in “ SBBC virtual sailing marks -2026” may be specified in specific races.
